Prohibition of acceptance of federal funds.

- 12 (a) The state superintendent of public instruction may, for the state and school districts, prohibit the 13

Τ	acceptance of any federal funds for k-12 public education
2	and may prohibit further expenditure of federal funds
3	received if in the judgment of the state superintendent:

5	(i) The use of the federal funds is not in the
6	financial interest of Wyoming's citizens;
7	
8	(ii) The use of the federal funds would require
9	the use of specific textbooks or teaching materials
10	contrary to article 7, section 11 of the Wyoming
11	constitution;

13	(iii) The use of the federal funds is not in
14	the best interests of Wyoming's citizens;
15	
16	(iv) Delay in the use of the federal funds is
17	required to consult Wyoming's citizens or the Wyoming
18	legislature on the wisdom of accepting or expending
19	specific federal funds considering the conditions attached
20	thereto; or

1	(v) The federal statute, rules and regulations
2	or federal agency guidance is inadequate to determine what
3	the federal requirements are for the use of the funds.
4	
5	(b) Nothing in subsection (a) of this section shall
6	be construed as limiting the governor's power to reject
7	federal funding.

9	Section 2. W.S. 21-2-202(a)(xix) by creating a new
10	subparagraph (K) and 21-3-111(a)(v) are amended to read:
11	
12	21-2-202. Duties of the state superintendent.
13	
14	(a) In addition to any other duties assigned by law,
15	the state superintendent shall:
16	
17	(xix) Serve as the state agency to accept all
18	federal funds for aid to education, except as provided in
19	W.S. 21-2-307 and 21-2-601, and as the agency to administer
20	or supervise the administration of any state plan
21	established or federal funds subject to federal

requirements. Each acceptance is restricted in its effect

1	to the specific situation involved. The state
2	superintendent may:
3	
4	(K) Prohibit acceptance of federal funds
5	for K-12 public education by the state and school districts
6	in accordance with W.S. 21-2-205.
7	
8	21-3-111. Powers of boards of trustees.
9	
10	(a) The board of trustees in each school district
11	within the state may:

13	(v) <u>Subject to W.S. 21-2-202(a)(xix) and 21-2-</u>
14	205, accept or reject any federal or other gift, grant,
15	bequest, or devise;

17	Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
18	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
19	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
20	Constitution.
