Phase I: All departments retain autonomy as individual academic units during FY23. Budget reductions made after moving the departments to the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources. b. Phase II: College completes organizational and budget reorganization into ~ 3 larger academic units by FY 24. c. The College of Agriculture and Natural Resources will work with the College of Arts & Sciences, Academic Affairs, HR, and Financial Affairs on implementation, including staffing plans and budgets/budget reductions.
