- 1 AN ACT relating to the business ready community program; 2 amending requirements for grants and loans under the program; providing for the recapture of funds associated 3 4 with grants and loans under the program as specified; 5 removing a restriction on interest rates for loans; making conforming amendments; specifying applicability; requiring 6 7 rulemaking; and providing for effective dates. 8 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
- 11 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-12-601(c) and (g) is amended to 12 read:

2	9-12-601. Wyoming business ready community program;
3	purpose; creation; rulemaking.
4	
5	(c) Grants and loans made under this section shall
6	be subject to the following conditions:
7	
8	(i) Grants shall be matching grants as determined
9	by the council: Loans shall be made at no or low interest
10	rates.
11	
12	(ii) The minimum interest rate for loans shall
13	be set at the prevailing United States department of
14	treasury rate for bonds of comparable maturity to the loan
15	term;
16	
17	(iii) Grants for revenue generating projects
18	shall provide for repayment of the grant funds in
19	accordance with the following:
20	
21	(A) The minimum revenue recapture
22	percentage shall be not less than the percentage of the
23	project cost covered by the grant, provided that the

1	revenue recapture percentage for a project covered by a
2	grant shall not exceed fifty percent (50%);
3	
4	(B) The amount of revenue recaptured may
5	exceed the amount of the original grant;
6	
7	(C) Revenue generated by the project may be
8	recaptured for the full expected life of the revenue
9	generating asset.
10	
11	(iv) If a project that is covered in whole or in
12	part by a grant or a loan under this section is sold,
13	assigned or transferred:
14	
15	(A) All revenues generated by the sale,
16	assignment or transfer shall be utilized to retire the
17	project loan, if a loan was issued to cover part or all of
18	the project costs;
19	
20	(B) After the loan is paid in full or if a
21	grant was used to cover part or all of the project costs, a
22	percentage of revenues generated by the sale, assignment or
23	transfer not less than the percentage of the project cost

- 1 covered by the grant or loan shall be remitted to the
- 2 council and deposited in the business ready community
- 3 <u>account under W.S. 9-12-602</u>.

4

- 5 (g) Repayments of loans under this section shall be
- 6 credited to the business ready community account. The
- 7 council shall promulgate rules and regulations to identify
- 8 the type and maximum amount, as a percentage of the total
- 9 grant, of the revenue that may be recaptured and credited
- 10 to the account as a result of grants under this section,
- 11 subject to subparagraph (c)(iii)(A) of this section.

- 13 Section 2. The provisions of this act shall only
- 14 apply to grants and loans issued on or after the effective
- 15 date of this section.

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- 17 **Section 3.** The Wyoming business council shall
- 18 promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with the
- 19 provisions of this act.

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1 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this 2 section, this act is effective July 1, 2022.

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4 (b) Sections 3 and 4 are effective immediately upon

5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
