A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to corporations; amending statutory 2 provisions regulating decentralized autonomous organizations; amending definitions; making technical 3 corrections; amending the obligations of members and 4 5 dissociated members; amending factors for dissolution of a 6 decentralized autonomous organization; repealing 7 definitions and provisions related to decentralized autonomous organizations; and providing for an effective 8 9 date.

2	ownership share <u>right</u> in a <u>member managed</u> decentralized
3	autonomous organization, which may be defined in the
4	entity's determined by the organization's articles of
5	organization , smart contract or operating agreement <u>or</u>
6	ascertainable from a blockchain on which the organization
7	relies to determine a member's ownership right. A
8	membership interest may also be characterized as either a
9	digital security or a digital consumer asset as defined in
10	W.S. 34-29-101, if designated as such in the organization's
11	articles of organization or operating agreement;

13 (ix) "Smart contract" means an automated transaction, as defined in W.S. 40-21-102(a)(ii), or any 14 15 substantially similar analogue, which is comprised of or code, script or programming language relying on a 16 17 blockchain that executes the terms of an agreement and 18 which may include taking custody of and transferring an 19 asset, administrating membership interest votes with respect to a decentralized autonomous organization or 20 21 issuing executable instructions for these actions, based on 22 the occurrence or nonoccurrence of specified conditions.

Application of Wyoming Limited Liability 2 Company Act. 3 4 (a) The Wyoming Limited Liability Company Act applies to decentralized autonomous organizations to the extent not 5 inconsistent with the provisions of this chapter, and the б powers provided to the secretary of state by W.S. 7 8 17-29-1102 shall apply to this chapter. 9 17-31-104. Definition and election of decentralized 10 autonomous organization status. 11 12 (e) A statement in the articles of organization may 13 define shall establish how the decentralized autonomous 14 organization shall be as either a member managed 15 16 decentralized autonomous organization or an algorithmically 17 managed decentralized autonomous organization. If the type 18 of decentralized autonomous organization is not otherwise 19 provided for, the limited liability company will be 20 presumed to be a member managed decentralized autonomous 21 organization. managed by the members, including to what extent the management will be conducted algorithmically. 22

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16	Management of a decentralized autonomous organization shall
17	be vested in its members , if member managed, or the smart
18	contract, the members and any applicable smart contracts.
19	All smart contracts utilized by a decentralized autonomous
20	organization shall be capable of being updated, modified or
21	otherwise upgraded if algorithmically managed, unless
22	otherwise provided in the articles of organization or
23	operating agreement.

To the extent the information is available on an open 2 3 blockchain, members and dissociated members shall have no 4 right under W.S. 17-29-410 to separately inspect or copy 5 records of a decentralized autonomous organization and the organization shall have no obligation to furnish any 6 information to members or dissociated members concerning 7 8 the organization's activities, financial condition or other 9 circumstances to the extent the information is available on 10 an open blockchain. 11 12 17-31-113. Withdrawal of members. 13 14 (a) A member may only withdraw from a decentralized autonomous organization in accordance with the terms set 15 16 forth in the articles of organization, the smart contracts 17 or, if applicable, the operating agreement. 18 17-31-114. Dissolution. 19 20 21 (a) A decentralized autonomous organization organized under this chapter shall be dissolved upon the occurrence 22 of any of the following events: 23
