- 12 **Section 1.** W.S. 16-4-203(d)(iii) and (xi) are amended 13 to read:

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16-4-203. Right of inspection; grounds for denial;
3 access of news media; order permitting or restricting

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6 (d) The custodian shall deny the right of inspection 7 of the following records, unless otherwise provided by law:

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9 (iii) Personnel files except those files shall 10 be available to the duly elected and appointed officials 11 who supervise the work of the person in interest. 12 Applications, performance ratings and 13 achievement data shall be available only to the person in interest and to the duly elected and appointed officials 14 supervise his work. Employment contracts, working 15 16 agreements or other documents setting forth the terms and conditions of employment of public officials and employees 17 are not considered part of a personnel file and shall be 18 public inspection. Investigations or 19 available for disciplinary proceedings resulting 20 in substantiated 21 allegations of professional misconduct by Wyoming school district employees related to the treatment of or 22

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1 interactions with students are not considered part of a 2 personnel file and, subject to the redaction of personally identifiable student information, shall be available for 3 public inspection upon the conclusion of any investigation 4 or disciplinary proceeding, or if an appeal is pursued, 5 6 after resolution of the appeal of the investigation or disciplinary proceeding. Records associated with the 7 suspension, dismissal or termination of a continuing 8 9 contract teacher pursuant to W.S. 21-7-106 and 21-7-110 are 10 not considered part of a personnel file and, subject to the 11 redaction of personally identifiable student information, 12 shall be available for public inspection after final action by the board of trustees and resolution of any appeal, if 13 14 applicable; 15 (xi) Records or information compiled solely for 16 17 purposes of investigating violations of, and enforcing, 18 internal personnel rules or personnel policies 19 disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted 20 invasion of personal privacy. Subject to paragraph (iii) of 21 subsection, this exemption this does not apply to

investigations or disciplinary proceedings resulting in
