1 AN ACT relating to the safe school and climate act; clarifying application of the act; modifying requirements; 2 3 making conforming amendments; and providing for an effective date. 4 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 6 7 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-4-313(a)(intro), 21-4-314(a), 9 (b)(iii), (iv), (ix), (c) and (e) are amended to read: 10 11 21-4-313. Prohibition against harassment, intimidation or bullying; reporting to school officials. 12 13

1	(a) No person, including but not limited to students,
2	school or district employees, administrators or volunteers,
3	shall engage in:
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5	21-4-314. School district implementation; state
6	policies, training and technical assistance.
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8	(a) <del>Not later than December 31, 2009, <u>E</u>ach school</del>
9	district shall adopt a policy prohibiting, at a minimum,
10	harassment, intimidation or bullying at school. The school
11	district shall involve parents and guardians, school
12	employees, volunteers, students, administrators and
13	community representatives in the process of creating the
14	policy. The policy shall address harassment, intimidation
15	or bullying occurring or received at school committed by
16	any person, including but not limited to students, school
17	or district employees, administrators and volunteers.
18	Policies created under this section shall be continuously
19	reviewed and may be revised as necessary.
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21	(b) The policy prohibiting harassment, intimidation
22	or bullying shall include, without limitation:

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1 (iii) Consequences and appropriate remedial 2 actions for persons, including but not limited to students, 3 school or district employees, administrators and 4 volunteers, committing acts of harassment, intimidation or bullying or engaging in reprisal or retaliation; 5 6 7 (iv) Procedures for reporting and documenting acts of harassment, intimidation or bullying, including a 8 9 provision for reporting anonymously. However, formal 10 disciplinary action shall not be taken solely on the basis 11 of an anonymous report. The procedures shall identify the 12 appropriate school personnel responsible for receiving a report and investigating a complaint, including procedures 13 for investigation of anonymous reports; 14 15 16 (ix) A process for discussing the district's 17 harassment, intimidation or bullying policy with students, school or district employees, administrators 18 and 19 volunteers; and 20 21 (c) To assist local school districts in developing a policy under subsection (b) of this section, the department 22

23 of education shall not later than September 1,  $\frac{2009}{2023}$ ,

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1 develop model policies applicable to grades kindergarten through twelve (12) and teacher preparation program 2 3 standards on the identification and prevention of bullying. 4 In addition, the department shall provide necessary training programs and technical assistance to districts in 5 carrying out this act. 6 7 8 (e) Information regarding the school district's policy against harassment, intimidation or bullying shall 9 10 incorporated into each district's professional be 11 development programs and shall be provided to volunteers 12 and other noncertified employees of the district who have significant contact with students. 13 14 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2023. 15
