## for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming lottery; authorizing scratch-off ticket games; providing for the distribution of 2 net proceeds attributable to scratch-off ticket games; 3 creating an account; requiring funds in the account to be 4 5 expended to support outdoor recreation as specified; making 6 conforming amendments; authorizing rulemaking; providing 7 applicability; and providing for effective dates. 8 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 10 Section 1. W.S. 9-17-129 is created to read: 11

There is created the outdoor recreation office funding 5 account. The state treasurer shall credit to the account б 7 those funds attributable to scratch-off ticket games as 8 specified under W.S. 9-17-111(b). Interest and other earnings on funds within the account shall be credited to 9 10 the account. Funds in the account shall be expended by the 11 department of state parks and cultural resources upon 12 appropriation by the legislature to support outdoor recreation areas and facilities. 13

15 Section 2. W.S. 9-17-103(a)(vi) and by creating new 16 paragraph (xvi), 9-17-108(a)(i) and 9-17-111(b)(intro) are 17 amended to read:

19 **9-17-103.** Definitions.

21 (a) As used in this chapter:

1 (vi) "Lottery," "lotteries," "lottery game" or "lottery games" means any game of chance approved by the 2 3 board and operated pursuant to this chapter, specifically 4 limited to a state lottery, or a multi-state lottery and state and multi-state scratch-off ticket games, and shall 5 not include other instant tickets, scratch-off tickets, 6 video lottery terminals or any other electronic game 7 involving direct physical contact between the player and a 8 machine; 9 10 11 (xvi) "Scratch-off ticket" means a game ticket 12 with a covering over the game symbols located in the play 13 area that when scratched reveals a specific result. 14 9-17-108. Adoption by board of procedures regulating 15 16 conduct of lottery games. 17 (a) The board may adopt regulations, policies and 18 19 procedures regulating the conduct of lottery games in 20 general, including, but not limited to, regulations, 21 policies and procedures specifying:

1	(i) The type of games to be conducted,
2	specifically limited to a state lottery <u>,</u> or a multi-state
3	lottery and state and multi-state scratch-off ticket games,
4	and shall not include <u>other</u> instant-win tickets,
5	scratch-off ticket games, video lottery terminals or any
б	other electronic game involving direct physical contact
7	between the player and a machine;

9	9-17-111. Disposition of lottery proceeds.
10	
11	(b) On or before the fifteenth day of each quarter,
12	the corporation shall transfer to the treasurer's office,
13	for credit to the lottery account which is hereby created,
14	at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the net proceeds
15	from the preceding quarter. Final reconciliation of the
16	transfer to the state under this subsection shall be
17	determined at the end of each fiscal year based on the
18	audited annual financial statements. <u>Net proceeds</u>
19	attributable to scratch-off ticket games shall be accounted
20	for separately from all other net proceeds. Upon their
21	deposit into the account, any monies representing a deposit
22	of net proceeds shall then become the unencumbered property
23	of the state of Wyoming and the corporation shall have no

power to agree or undertake otherwise. At least once per 1 2 fiscal year, net proceeds attributable to scratch-off 3 ticket games credited to the lottery account shall be paid 4 by the state treasurer to the outdoor recreation office 5 funding account created by W.S. 9-17-129. At least once per fiscal year, these monies all other net proceeds credited 6 to the lottery account shall be paid by the treasurer to 7 8 the treasurers of the counties, cities and towns for 9 payment into their respective general funds. The percentage 10 of the balance that will be distributed to each county and its cities and towns will be determined by computing the 11 12 percentage that sales of lottery tickets collected by retailers in each county including its cities and towns 13 bear to total sales of lottery tickets collected by 14 retailers in all counties including their cities and towns. 15 16 This percentage of the monies shall be distributed within 17 each county as follows:

19 Section 3. The amendments to W.S. 9-17-111(b) made by 20 this act shall apply to net proceeds attributable to 21 scratch-off ticket games generated on or after January 1, 22 2024.

1	Section 4. The Wyoming lottery corporation shall take
2	action as necessary to bring scratch-off ticket games to
3	market by January 1, 2024 or as soon thereafter as is
4	practicable, including conducting market research, creating
5	a launch strategy and distribution methodology and adopting
6	rules relating to the conduct of scratch-off ticket games.
7	
8	Section 5.
9	
10	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this
11	section, this act is effective January 1, 2024.
12	
13	(b) Sections 4 and 5 of this act are effective
14	immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a
15	bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of
16	the Wyoming Constitution.
