16 Section 1. W.S. 34-29-107 is created to read:

1 **34-29-107. Production of private keys; prohibition.**

2

3 No person shall be compelled to produce a private key or
4 make a private key known to any other person in any civil,
5 criminal, administrative, legislative or other proceeding
6 in this state that relates to a digital asset, other
7 interest or right to which the private key provides access
8 unless a public key is unavailable or unable to disclose
9 the requisite information with respect to the digital
10 asset, other interest or right. This paragraph shall not be
11 interpreted to prohibit any lawful proceeding that compels
12 a person to produce or disclose a digital asset, other
13 interest or right to which a private key provides access,
14 or to disclose information about the digital asset, other
15 interest or right, provided that the proceeding does not
16 require production or disclosure of the private key.
