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(b) Until such time as the amount is adjusted as
provided in this subsection, the amount to be received by
each member of the legislature for expenses shall be one
hundred nine dollars (\$109.00) one hundred fifty-five
dollars (\$155.00) per day. The amount shall be adjusted as
of July 1 each year by the state auditor to an amount equal
to the most recent standard per diem rate established by
the United States general services administration for
travel within Wyoming.

Section 2.

(a) There is appropriated one hundred ten thousand dollars (\$110,000.00) from the general fund to the legislative service office for purposes of supplementing the per diem provided to legislators as required by this act.

20 (b) There is appropriated fifty thousand dollars
21 (\$50,000.00) from the general fund to the state auditor's
22 office for purposes of supplementing the per diem provided
23 to members of any state board, commission, council,

- 1 authority or other state entity whose rate of per diem is
