AN ACT relating to state employees and officials group insurance; providing for enrollment by legislators and their dependents in the state employees and officials group insurance plan; providing for legislators who participate in the program to pay the full cost of their premiums; providing a definition; granting rulemaking authority; and providing for an effective date.

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        (f) A member of the legislature shall be deemed as a
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    person employed on a regular, halftime basis for purposes
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    of obtaining and maintaining coverage under the group

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12 state agency, department or institution, including the University of Wyoming and the community 13 14 colleges in the state, shall pay monthly to the department 15 the amount established and appropriated by the legislature 16 for each eligible employee or official, except legislators, 17 electing to become covered by any portion of the group insurance plan as the contribution of the state to that 18 19 plan during the period the employee or official is enrolled 20 in the plan. Amounts appropriated by the legislature from 21 the general fund for University of Wyoming and community college employer contributions under this section shall 22 include amounts necessary to fully fund the employer's 23

1	contribution for those eligible and enrolled employees
2	whose compensation is partially or fully funded from
3	nonfederal sources, but the University of Wyoming shall
4	exclude amounts necessary to fully fund the employer's
5	contribution for those eligible and enrolled employees

8	are not available, the amounts necessary to fully fund the
9	employer's contribution for those eligible and enrolled
10	employees shall be included in the general fund
11	appropriation. If the monthly premium for coverage of the
12	employee or official is less than the amount established
13	and appropriated by the legislature, the balance may be
14	applied to the premium for coverage of dependents, or to
15	the premium for any optional group insurance coverage made
16	available by the department, if so elected.

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(f) Legislators who elect coverage under the group
insurance plan shall pay the full cost of the premium
coverage for themselves and their dependents as established
by the department.

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2 Any member of the legislature eligible for (a) 3 membership in the group insurance plan on January 7, 4 2025 shall have thirty-one (31) days after that date to either elect to be enrolled or not be enrolled in the 5 The department shall establish the procedure by 6 which eligible legislators shall notify the department of 7 8 their decision within the prescribed thirty-one (31) day

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period.

11 The department of administration and information (b) 12 shall promulgate all rules necessary to effectuate the 13 purpose of this act. The department shall adopt procedures for deductions and remittances to cover a legislator's 14 15 monthly contributions for enrollment in the group insurance 16 plan for the legislator and any covered dependents pursuant 17 W.S. 9-3-211(a). These procedures may include deductions from the enrolled legislator's monthly state pay 18 19 or from the enrolled legislator's checking or savings 20 account if the legislator's monthly state pay 21 insufficient to cover the full cost of the legislator's monthly contribution. 22
