INTRODUCTION**

Delta-8 controlled substances.

Sponsored by: Joint Judiciary Interim Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to controlled substances; clarifying that  
2 delta-8 tetrahydrocannabinol and its isomers are included  
3 in schedule I of the Wyoming Controlled Substances Act of  
4 1971; requiring rulemaking; and providing for an effective  
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-1014(d)(xxi) is amended to read:

11 **35-7-1014. Substances included in Schedule I.**

1 (d) Hallucinogenic substances.-Unless specifically  
2 excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any  
3 material, compound, mixture or preparation which contains  
4 any quantity of the following hallucinogenic substances,  
5 their salts, isomers and salts of isomers whenever the  
6 existence of these salts, isomers and salts of isomers is  
7 possible within the specific chemical designation (for  
8 purposes of this paragraph only, the term "isomer" includes  
9 the optical, position and geometric isomers):

11 (xxi) Tetrahydrocannabinols; synthetic  
12 equivalents of the substances contained in the plant or in  
13 the resinous extractives of Cannabis, sp. and/or synthetic  
14 substances, derivatives and their isomers with similar  
15 chemical structure and pharmacological activity such as the  
16 following: delta 1 cis or trans tetrahydrocannabinol and  
17 their optical isomers; delta 6 cis or trans  
18 tetrahydrocannabinol and their optical isomers; delta 8 cis  
19 or trans tetrahydrocannabinol and their optical isomers;  
20 delta to the 3, 4 cis or trans tetrahydrocannabinol and its  
21 optical isomers. Since nomenclature of these substances is  
22 not internationally standardized, compounds of these

1 structures, regardless of numerical designation of atomic  
2 positions are covered;

4       **Section 2.** The commissioner of drugs and substances  
5 control shall promulgate all rules necessary to implement  
6 this act.

7

8       **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2024.
