- for AN ACT relating to controlled substances; clarifying that 1 2 delta-8 tetrahydrocannabinol and its isomers are included 3 in schedule I of the Wyoming Controlled Substances Act of 1971; requiring rulemaking; and providing for an effective 4 5 date. 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 **Section 1**. W.S. 35-7-1014(d)(xxi) is amended to read:

1 Hallucinogenic substances.-Unless specifically (d) 2 excepted or unless listed in another schedule, 3 material, compound, mixture or preparation which contains 4 any quantity of the following hallucinogenic substances, their salts, isomers and salts of isomers whenever the 5 existence of these salts, isomers and salts of isomers is 6 possible within the specific chemical designation (for 7 8 purposes of this paragraph only, the term "isomer" includes 9 the optical, position and geometric isomers):

(xxi) Tetrahydrocannabinols; 11 synthetic 12 equivalents of the substances contained in the plant or in the resinous extractives of Cannabis, sp. and/or synthetic 13 substances, derivatives and their isomers with similar 14 15 chemical structure and pharmacological activity such as the 16 following: delta 1 cis or trans tetrahydrocannabinol and 17 optical isomers; delta 6 cis their or trans tetrahydrocannabinol and their optical isomers; delta 8 cis 18 19 or trans tetrahydrocannabinol and their optical isomers; 20 delta to the 3, 4 cis or trans tetrahydrocannabinol and its 21 optical isomers. Since nomenclature of these substances is internationally standardized, compounds 22 not of these
