A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to guardianships and conservatorships;
2 allowing guardianship and conservatorship letters to be
3 renewed as specified; authorizing termination of
4 guardianships and conservatorships as specified; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 3-2-104 by creating a new subsection
10 (c), 3-3-104 by creating a new subsection (c) and 3-3-
11 1101(a)(iv) are amended to read:

13 **3-2-104. Appointment of guardian.**

2 (c) Upon the appointment of a guardian and the filing
3 of an oath by the guardian, the clerk of district court
4 shall issue a letter of guardianship for a period of one
5 (1) year that may be renewed annually with the filing of
6 guardian reports pursuant to W.S. 3-2-109.

7

8 **3-3-104. Appointment of conservator.**

9

10 (c) Upon the appointment of a conservator and the
11 filing of an oath by the conservator, the clerk of district
12 court shall issue a letter of conservatorship for a period
13 of one (1) year that may be renewed annually with the
14 filing of conservator reports pursuant to W.S. 3-3-901.

15

16 **3-3-1101. Cause for termination.**

17

18 (a) A guardianship shall cease, and a conservatorship
19 shall terminate, upon the occurrence of any of the
20 following circumstances:

21

22 (iv) A determination by the court that the
23 guardian or conservator is not acting in the best interest

1 of the ward, including failing to file a guardianship
2 report pursuant to W.S. 3-2-109 or failing to file a
3 conservatorship report pursuant to W.S. 3-3-901. In such
4 case, the court shall appoint another guardian or
5 conservator;

7 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2024.
