1 (e) Commencing with the budget request for the fiscal 2 year 2010-2026 and for each fiscal year thereafter, the 3 department shall prepare an exception budget request 4 necessary to adjust the amounts calculated pursuant to subsections (b) and (d) of this section and as previously 5 adjusted pursuant to this subsection, to reflect the most 6 recent external cost adjustment enacted by the legislature 7 8 pursuant to W.S. 21-13-309(o). The intent of this 9 subsection is for each budget request to incorporate all 10 previous adjustments made pursuant to this subsection.

12 Section 2. There is appropriated twelve million two 13 hundred ninety thousand three hundred twenty-eight dollars (\$12,290,328.00) from the general fund to the department of 14 health to be allocated pursuant to W.S. 21-2-706, as 15 16 amended by section 1 of this act. This appropriation shall 17 be for the period beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2026. This appropriation shall not be transferred or 18 19 any other purpose and expended for any unexpended, 20 unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall 21 revert as provided by law on June 30, 2026. It is the intent of the legislature that this appropriation be 22

1 included in the standard budget for the department of 2 health for the immediately succeeding fiscal biennium.
