2 (i) Not later than October 1, 2024 for school 3 year 2024-2025, and not later than October 1, 2025 for 4 school year 2025-2026, school districts shall report to the state superintendent of public instruction the number of 5 unfilled vacancies for each school and district level 6 staffing category, including teachers, principals and 7 8 assistant principals, central office administrators, secretarial and clerical staff, operations and maintenance 9 10 staff, aides and media technicians and student transportation personnel. For purposes of this 11 12 subparagraph, "unfilled vacancies" means positions the 13 school district is actively seeking to fill or has sought to fill within the immediately preceding three (3) months 14 prior to reporting data; 15
