1	(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no
2	government official or election official in Wyoming shall
3	solicit, take or otherwise accept from any person any
4	contribution, donation or anything of value for purposes of
5	conducting an election. All costs and expenses relating to
6	elections shall be paid with public funds. This subsection
7	shall not apply to meals or food provided or donated in
8	support of election training or education and meals or food
9	provided on election day to poll workers and other election
10	staff.

12	(b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to
13	prohibit the acceptance and expenditure of federal funds
14	for elections as provided by law.

16	(c) Any person who violates subsection (a) of this
17	section shall be guilty of a felony punishable by not more
18	than five (5) years imprisonment, a fine of not more than
19	ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), or both.
