10 (a) For a primary election, an elector may declare or change party affiliation on an existing registration record 11 by completing an application signed before a notarial 12 officer or election official and filing it with the county 13 clerk before the first day on which an application for 14 15 nomination may be filed under W.S. 22-5-209. If a qualified 16 elector who was not registered to vote in Wyoming during 17 the immediately preceding twelve (12) month period registers to vote in Wyoming prior to or on the date of a 18 19 primary election the qualified elector may declare party 20 affiliation on the date of registration by completing an application signed before a notarial officer or election 21 official and filing it with the county clerk and thereafter 22 may change party affiliation as provided in this section. 23

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2024.
