1 AN ACT relating to banks, banking and finance; generally 2 exempting employees of the division of banking from state personnel classification and compensation provisions; 3 requiring the state banking board to establish personnel 4 5 classifications and salaries for positions within the 6 division of banking as specified; requiring reports; and 7 providing for an effective date.

5 (b) The banking board shall:

7 (viii) Except for the salary of the commissioner 8 as provided by W.S. 13-1-602(b), establish personnel classifications and salaries for the division of banking in 9 10 consultation with the director and subject to legislative 11 appropriation. Classifications and salaries shall be 12 commensurate with other state and federal financial regulators. The specialized skills required to supervise 13 special purpose depository institutions and financial 14 15 technology shall be defined by the state banking 16 commissioner. Classifications and salaries established 17 pursuant to this paragraph shall not be subject to any 18 classifications or any compensation plan established 19 pursuant to W.S. 9-2-3207(a)(i) and (ii), (b) and (c). The 20 provisions of W.S. 9-2-3207(a)(viii) shall not apply to 21 personnel of the division of banking. Upon the creation of the classifications and salaries for the division of 22 banking, and prior to the increase of any person's salary 23

1	pursuant to this paragraph, the division shall report the
2	classifications and salaries to the joint appropriations
3	committee. The report shall include any estimated increase
4	in requested appropriations, the duties of each person for
5	which the classification shall apply, including specific
6	skills required to skillfully and competently fill the
7	position, and any other information requested by the joint
8	appropriations committee. Salary increases requested
9	pursuant to this paragraph shall be included in the
LO	department's exception budget.

L2	Section 2. No increase in any person's salary under
L3	W.S. 13-1-605(b)(viii), as created by this act, or other
L 4	revision to personnel classifications for the division of
L5	banking that require an increase in the expenditure of
L6	funds shall be effective until approved by the governor.
