- For reference, W.S. 14-1-101(b)(vi) states: "A minor may 14 consent to health care treatment to the same extent as if he were an adult when any one (1) or more of the following circumstances apply: . . . The minor is twelve (12) years of age or older, is a smoker or user of tobacco products

and the health care to which the minor consents is a 1 tobacco cessation program approved by the department of health pursuant to W.S. 9-4-1204." In turn, W.S. 9-4-1204 requires the Department of Health to "develop and implement comprehensive tobacco prevention, cessation and treatment 6 programs for Wyoming" using funds from the income account 7 within the Wyoming Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund.
