1 AN ACT relating to the administration of the government; authorizing the governor to not cooperate with or assist 2 any federal land management agency as specified; 3 authorizing the governor to direct executive branch 4 5 agencies and encourage local governments to not cooperate with or assist any federal land management agency as 6 7 specified; limiting prosecution of statutes and rules during a period of non-cooperation; providing a sunset 8 9 date; and providing for an effective date.

11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

1 **Section 1**. W.S. 9-1-225 is created to read: 2 3 9-1-225. Cease cooperation or assistance; federal 4 agencies. 5 (a) If the governor determines in writing that any 6 federal land management agency is initiating, pursuing or 7 8 engaging in policies that harm the state, the governor may 9 cease to cooperate with or assist the agency. The governor 10 may resume cooperation and assistance with the federal land 11 management agency when the governor deems appropriate. 12 (b) The governor may direct each agency as defined by 13 W.S. 9-2-1002(a)(i) to not cooperate with or assist the 14 15 federal land management agency until the governor deems 16 appropriate under subsection (a) of this section. 17 18 (c) Except as otherwise provided, an agency shall not 19 be subject to enforcement of the state laws or regulations 20 relating to the cooperation or assistance of a federal land

management agency during the period of non-cooperation.

1	(d) A prosecutor shall not file or pursue charges
2	against an agency for a violation of a state law or
3	regulation relating to the cooperation or assistance of a
4	federal land management agency if the violation occurred
5	during the period of non-cooperation. This subsection shall
6	not apply to criminal offenses committed by an agency.

8	(e) The governor may encourage local government
9	officials to not cooperate or assist any federal land
10	management agency during the period of non-cooperation
11	deemed by the governor under subsection (a) of this
12	section.

14	(f) This section is repealed effective July 1, 2025.

16	Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
17	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
18	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
19	Constitution.
