6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 Section 1. W.S. 9-1-603(a)(vi) is amended to read:

10 **9-1-603. Duties generally; retention of qualified**  
11 **practicing attorneys; matters in which county or state is**  
12 **party or has interest; written opinions; assistance to**  
13 **county and district attorneys in felony trials.**

2 (a) The attorney general shall:

4 (vi) When requested, give written opinions upon  
5 questions submitted to him by:

7 (A) Elective and appointive state officers.  
8 ~~and by either branch of the legislature~~ Requests by any  
9 legislator, legislative committee or legislative body shall  
10 be submitted in accordance with subparagraphs (B) and (C)  
11 of this paragraph;

13 (B) The president of the senate, the  
14 speaker of the house of representatives, the chairman of a  
15 legislative standing committee or either legislative body,  
16 when in session in accordance with the rules of each house;

17

18 (C) The president of the senate or the  
19 speaker of the house of representatives when the  
20 legislature is not in session.

22 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2024.
