- 1 AN ACT relating to courts; increasing the maximum fines and
- 2 terms of imprisonment that municipal courts may impose; and

- 7 **Section 1**. W.S. 5-6-201(a), 5-6-210(a) and 5-6-301(a)
- 8 are amended to read:

- 10 5-6-201. Jurisdiction of municipal judge; change of
- 11 venue prohibited; exception for certain civil penalties.

1 (a) Except as provided by subsection (b) of this 2 section, a municipal judge has exclusive jurisdiction over 3 all violations of ordinances of the city. The municipal 4 judge shall hear and determine violations of ordinances and may impose fines not exceeding seven hundred fifty dollars 5 (\$750.00) one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or imprisonment 6 not exceeding six (6) months one (1) year, or both, to 7 8 which may be added costs. No change of venue shall be granted in any case arising under the ordinances of the 9 10 city.

5-6-210. Punishment regulated by ordinance; maximum fine and imprisonment.

15 (a) Any person convicted by a municipal judge of any 16 offense under any ordinance of the city shall be punished 17 by fine or imprisonment or both as provided by ordinance. Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, no 18 fine shall exceed seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) one 19 20 thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for any one (1) offense recoverable with costs, and no imprisonment shall exceed 21 22 six (6) months one (1) year.

5	(a) A person convicted before a municipal judge shall
6	be fined and imprisoned as provided by ordinance. Except as
7	provided by W.S. 15-1-103(a)(xli) or subsection (c) of this
8	section, no fine shall exceed seven hundred fifty dollars
9	(\$750.00) one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), and no
10	imprisonment shall exceed six (6) months one (1) year.
