STAFF COMMENT

 Per the Committee's direction, below is language that would provide for incremental increases to the maximum-liability amounts in W.S. 1-39-118(a). Please note that the dates and amounts provided below are just placeholders; the Committee will need to determine the frequency of changes and the maximum amounts for each period.

1-39-118. Maximum liability; insurance authorized.
