12	The Committee may wish to consider whether W.S. 9-1-704(f)			
13	requires amendment. That subsection provides that part-time			
14	peace officers or reserve peace officers must forfeit their			
15	position if they do not complete basic training within two			
16	years. The language is provided below:			
17 18	(f) Every person who is epociated as a part time or			
10 19	(f) Every person who is appointed as a part-time or reserve peace officer shall forfeit his position unless			
20	within two (2) years from the date of his appointment he is			
21	awarded a certificate by the director attesting that he			
22	satisfactorily completed a commission approved peace			
23	officer basic training program.

26	peace officer" is included as well (see W.S. 9-1-

28 29	(viii) "Part-time or reserve peace officer"			
30	means any person having peace officer authority acting less

32	or state agency, whether compensated or not;
