Re: Wyoming Gaming Commission, 2025-2026 Biennium Budget.

Dear Chairwoman Nethercott, Chairman Nicholas and members of the Joint Appropriations Committee.

The Wyoming Gaming Commission is a self-funded agency with a proposed biennial budget of over 70 million dollars, of which 9% is dedicated to administration. The remaining 91% is dedicated to the mandatory distributions as detailed in the Act. The proposed budget is a forward thinking biproduct of our current legislation and contemplates reasonable expansion while taking a conservative approach.

Customer Satisfaction/Service; We continue to visualize ways to optimize and provide a high level of customer service to all of our licensees as well as providing guidance for the applicants through the regulatory maze which the gaming industry fosters. The agency has a customer facing approach and commitment to address all requests in a timely fashion, knowing that time is money not only to the applicants but more importantly to the beneficiaries pursuant to the Act on all wagering activity.

Integrity and Accountability; The corner stone of the industry where all points originate from. Integrity underpins the gaming experience and our industry's success. From rigorous licensing regulations to thorough employee screening, the gaming industry is among the most robustly regulated business. We cultivate a deeply rooted culture of compliance through close partnerships and cooperation with all stakeholders. Interesting to note, as the public's confidence in the regulatory process increases, so will the wagering activity.

Racetrack Safety; As we embark on the future of horse racing the Commission is reenergizing its undying commitment to racetrack safety. During the 2023 racing season and after several injuries, we immediately increased our "Racing Soundness Exams" to accommodate 100% of the horses 100% of the time. While this program is not an easy task, we are committed to its continuance ensuring entrants are healthy and our Wyoming Tracks are safe. In the months to come, the Commission will be unveiling it's new and updated rules addressing racetrack safety.

Regulatory Efficiency's; Leveraging technology and achieving cost optimization. We will continue to embrace automation, virtual meetings, data analytics, and outsourcing several aspects when applicable.

Education and expertise; We will continue to foster partnerships with other gaming regulators with an underlining intent to better serve our Wyoming citizens. These partnerships and the participation in

educational forums will assist us in developing our expertise while preserving the original foundation. The Commissioners, Myself, and Staff aggressively participate in several national organizations to improve our regulatory knowledge and overall breadth of the industry. In 2024, we will be sharing some of this knowledge via educational opportunities with our legislative branch, local municipalities, and of course other executive branch staff members.

2025-2026 Biennium Budget Request summary; We are asking for 10 exceptions of which 3 are administrative positions and 1 is for administrative upgrades to computers and software.

Priority 1 – 1 FTE working as an Office Support Specialist II with paid benefits, supporting our other staff members in the administration of the Wyoming Bred Program.

Priority 2 – 1 temporary position to assist in the licensing of Pari-Mutuel Applicants during the summer overlapping race dates.

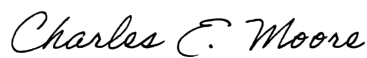
Priority 3 – 1 FTE working as a Gaming Compliance Senior Inspector with paid benefits, joining a highly trained and motivated group of individuals charged with overseeing all wagering activity. This includes the following: over 42 Off-Track Wagering locations, over 368 Skill Based Amusement Game locations, Online Sports Wagering, Charitable Gambling, and over 800 participants in the Wyoming Breeders Award Fund. We currently have 1 Supervisor, 3 Peace Officers, 2 Senior Inspectors, and 1 Senior Auditor monitoring all wagering activity covering over 97 thousand square miles.

Priority 4 – Computer replacement according to a four-year rotation cycle.

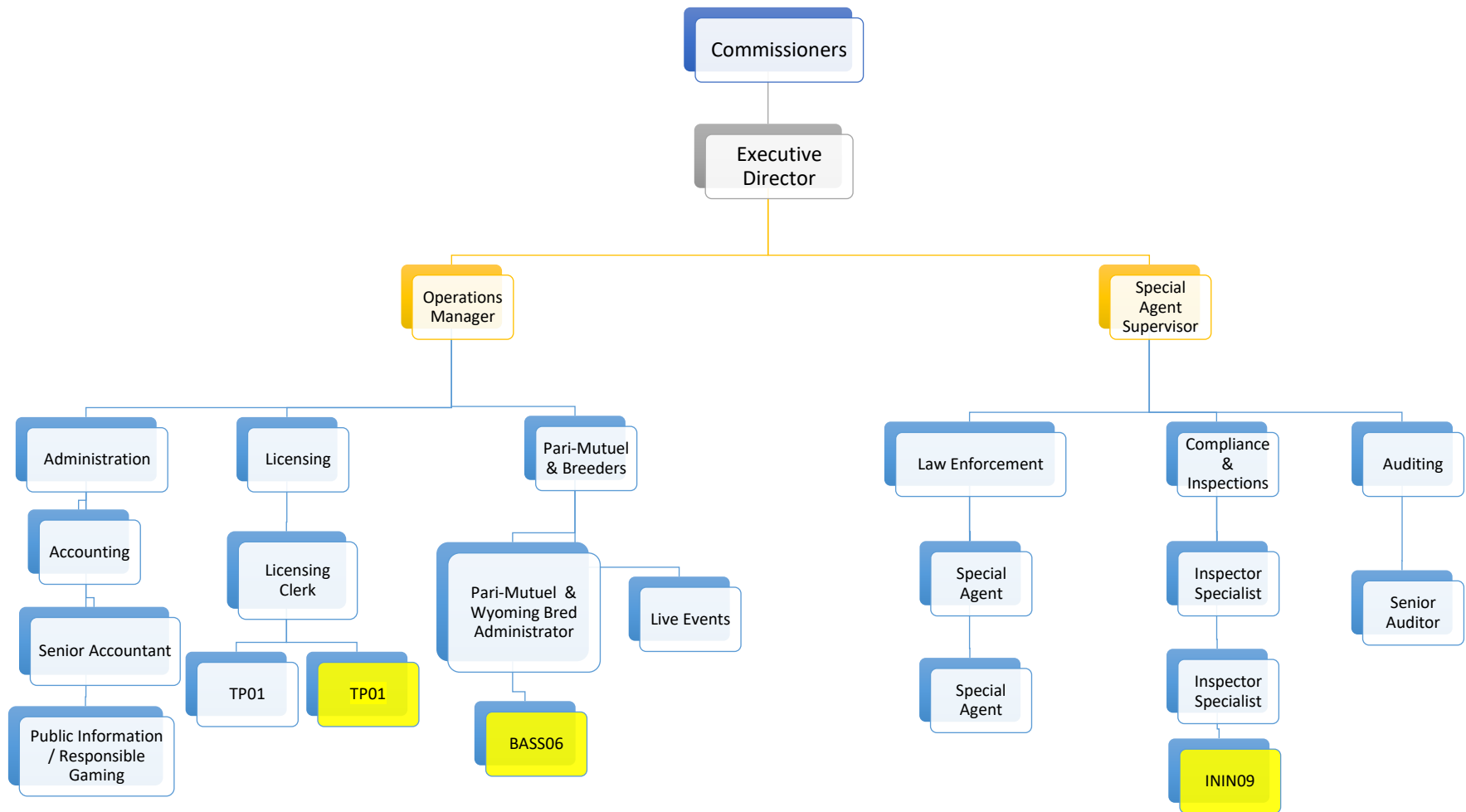
Priority 5 through 10 – The intent is to eliminate the ongoing need for B-11's, which deal with the mandatory distributions and an overall reorganization of the agency while providing more transparency and effectiveness in State government.

I am extremely optimistic about the future of gaming in the Cowboy State and the revenues generated for all of the beneficiaries. With a conservative and positive look to the future the Wyoming Gaming Commission asks you to join the Governor in his support of the aforementioned 2025-2026 Biennium Budget. We look forward to your questions and continued dialogue.

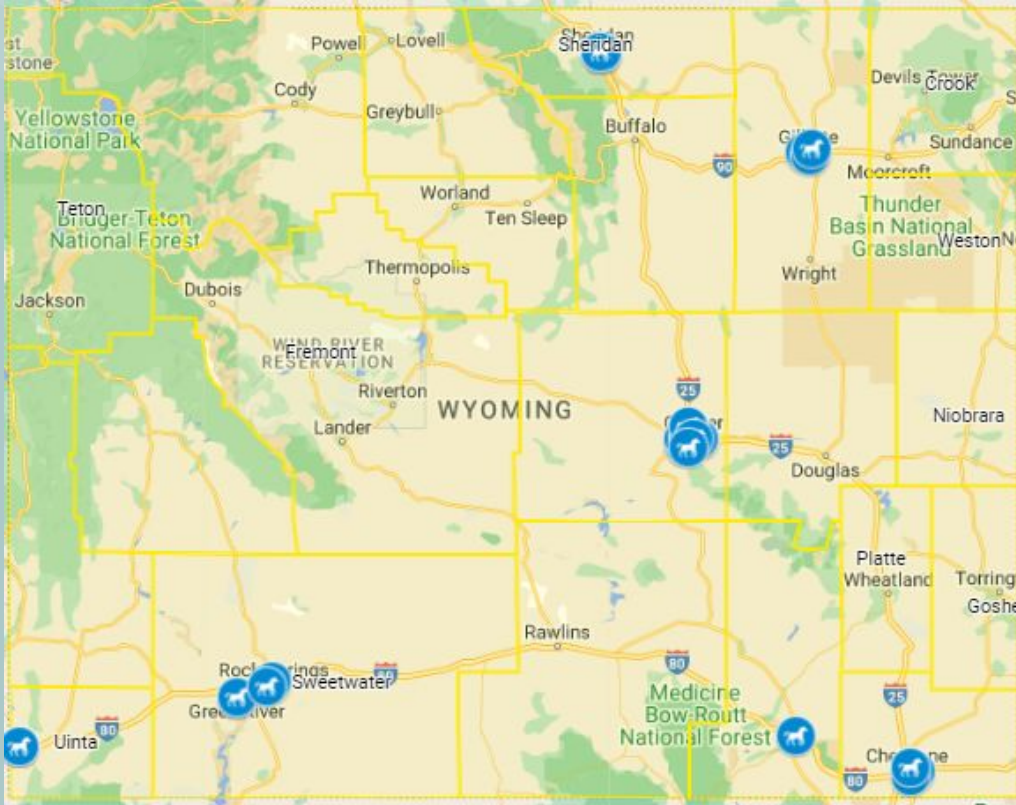

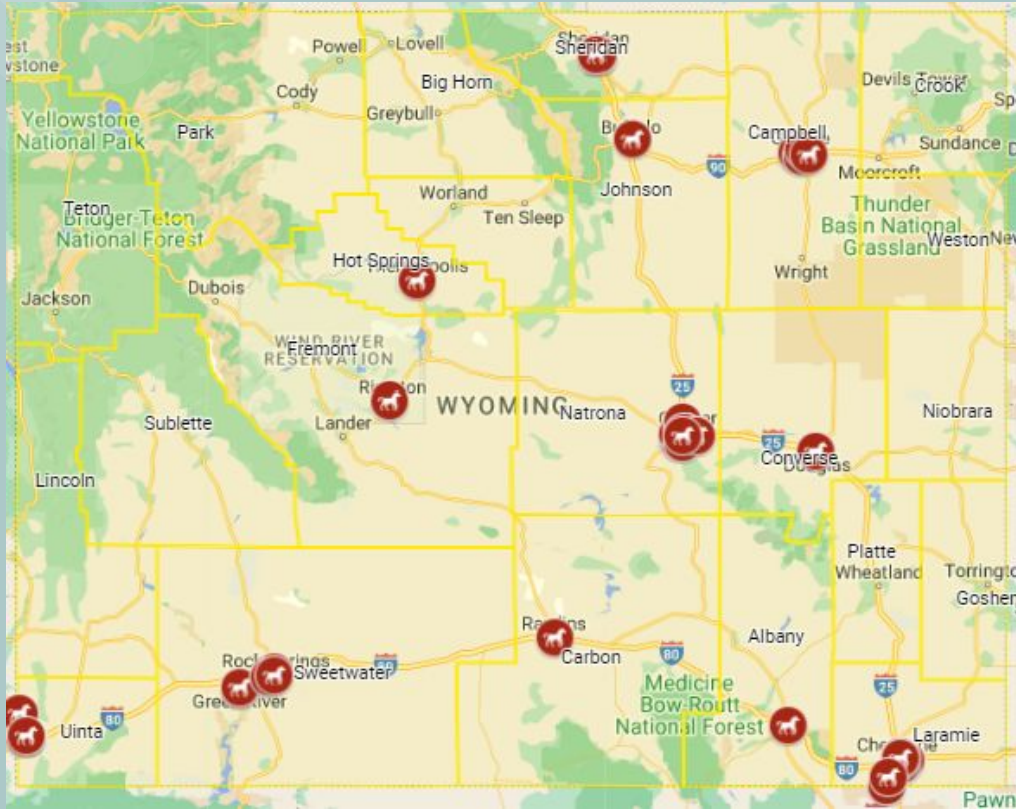




Off Track Betting - 2021

End of year 2021:

- * 27 off track wagering locations
- * 2 established operators
- * 1 new operator just beginning

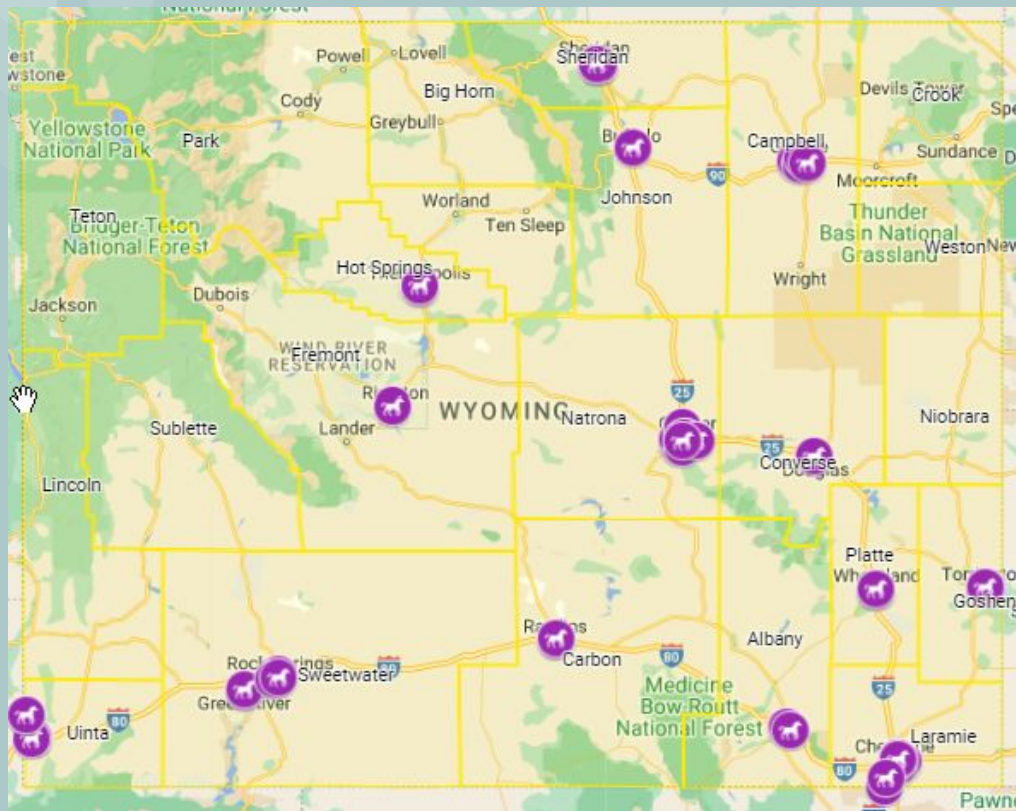


As of September 1st, 2023:

The addition of the third permitted operator contributed to a 55.5% increase in OTB operations throughout the State from 2021 to 2023.

Off Track Betting - As of September 1st, 2023

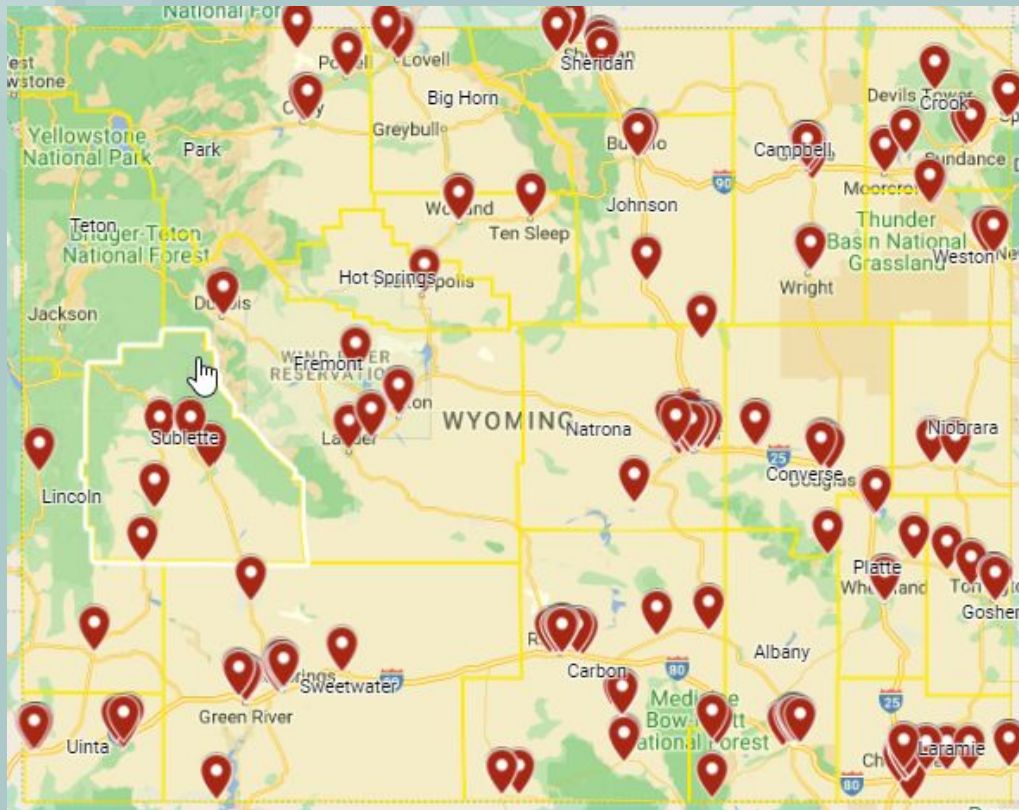


2025 Projections:

- * Estimating an additional 26% increase in OTB operations or 53 OTB's statewide.

This number could be low. Recently the Commission has received several calls from 2 large companies considering renovating tracks in Casper and Cheyenne to begin running more live race dates and begin simulcasting operations.

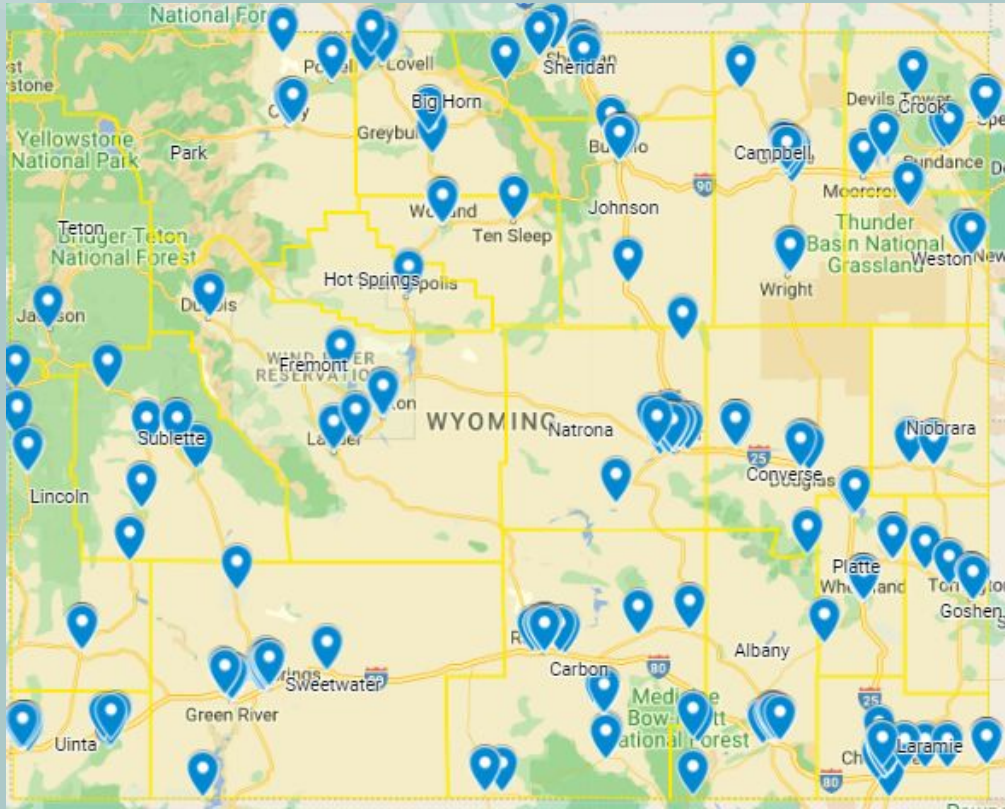
Off Track Betting - 2025 Projections

Skill Based Amusement Games - 2021

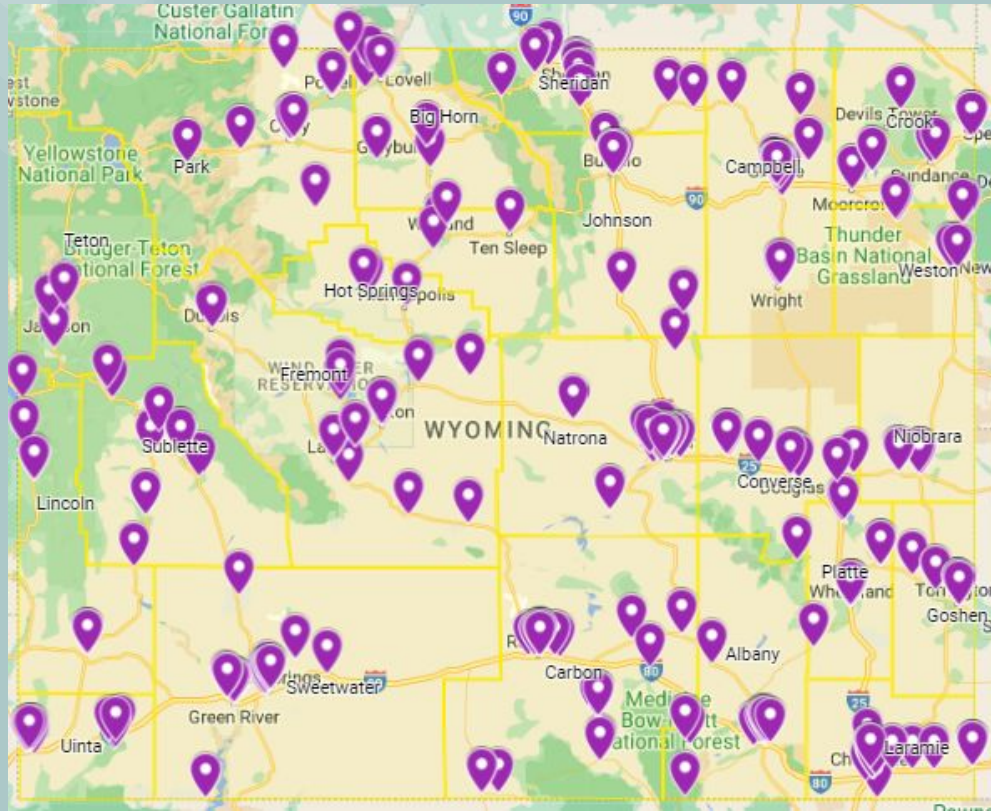


As of September 1st, 2023:

Skill Based Amusement Games - As of September 1st, 2023



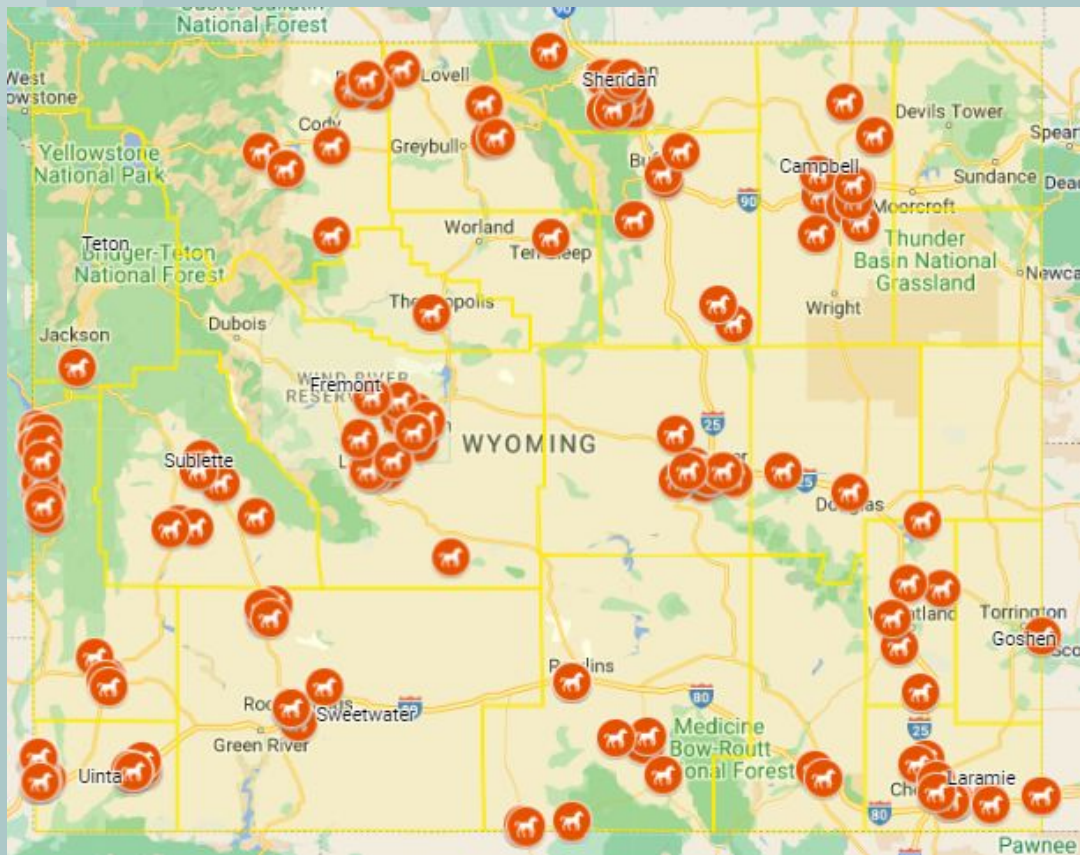
2025 Projections:

- * Conservatively estimating 480 projected locations by year end 2025

We are certain this number is low, it could be 100% growth, as we have seen 26% in 6 months.

A 100% increase could equate to 756 locations statewide.

Wyoming Breeder Awards Program - 2021

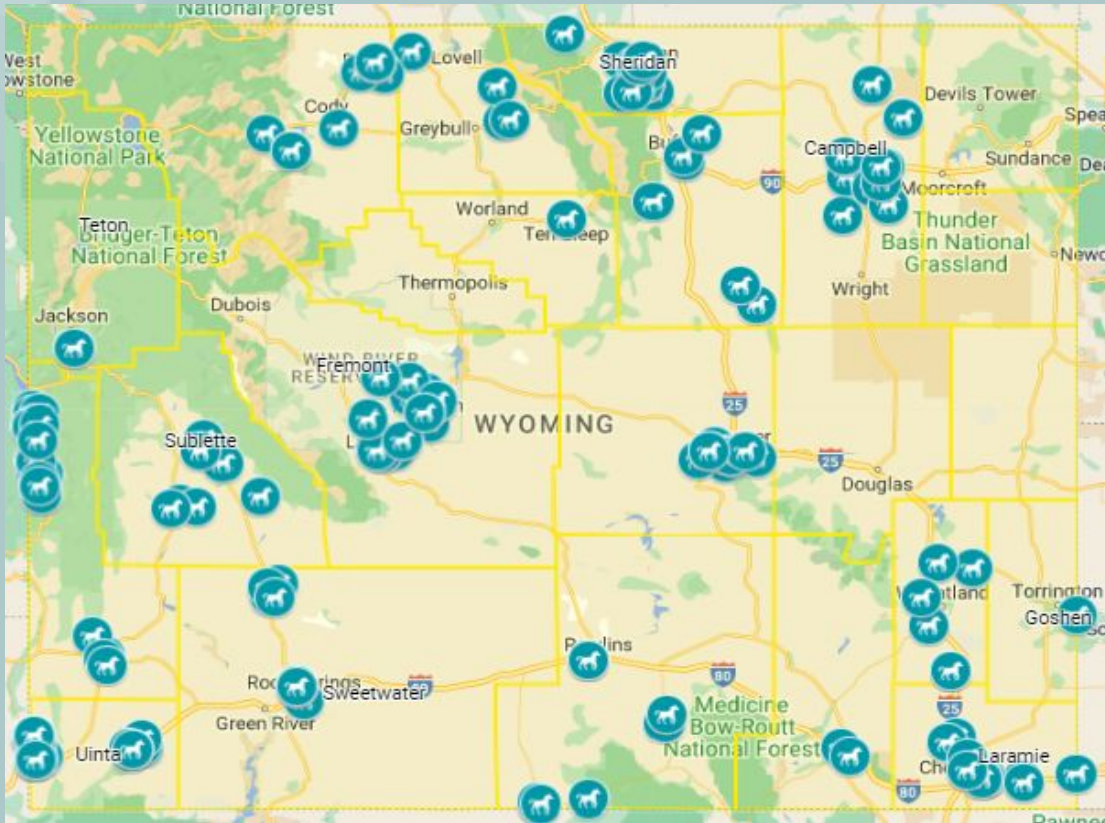

Wyoming Breeder Awards Program - 2025 Projected



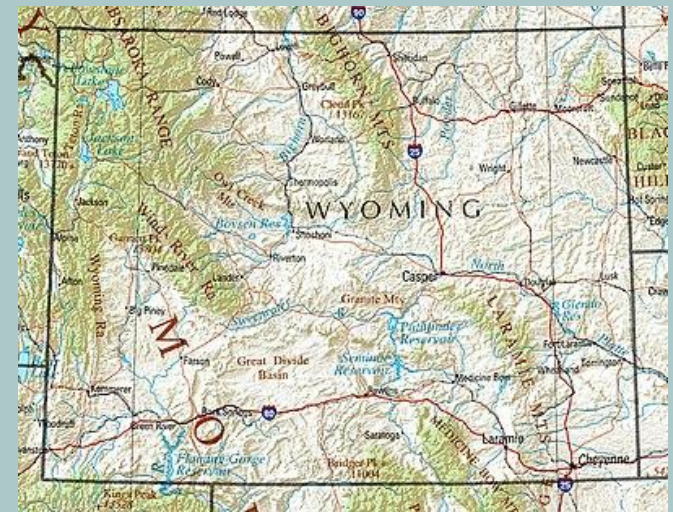

AGENCY COMPOSITION

Pursuant to W.S. § 11-25-101, the Wyoming Gaming Commission is created to be composed of nine (9) persons who have resided in the state for four (4) years and are qualified electors of Wyoming.

Pursuant to W.S. § 11-25-103, the governor, with the consent of the senate, shall appoint the nine (9) members of the Commission in accordance with W.S. §§ 28-12-101 through 28-12-103. Seven (7) of the nine (9) members shall be appointed from each appointment district under W.S. § 9-1-218. One (1) of the remaining members shall be, at the time of appointment and during the term of appointment, an active county or municipal law enforcement officer certified under title 9, chapter 1, article 7 of the Wyoming statutes. One (1) of the remaining members shall be an enrolled member of the Northern Arapaho or Eastern Shoshone Indian Tribe with not less than five (5) years of regulatory gaming experience.

Pursuant to W.S. § 9-1-218, the appointment districts are as follows:

- (ii) Albany, Carbon, and Sweetwater counties comprise district 2;
- (iii) Lincoln, Sublette, Teton, and Uinta counties comprise district 3;
- (iv) Campbell, Johnson, and Sheridan counties comprise district 4;
- (v) Big Horn, Hot Springs, Park, and Washakie counties comprise district 5;
- (vi) Crook, Niobrara, and Weston counties comprise district 6;
- (vii) Natrona, Fremont, and Converse counties comprise district 7.

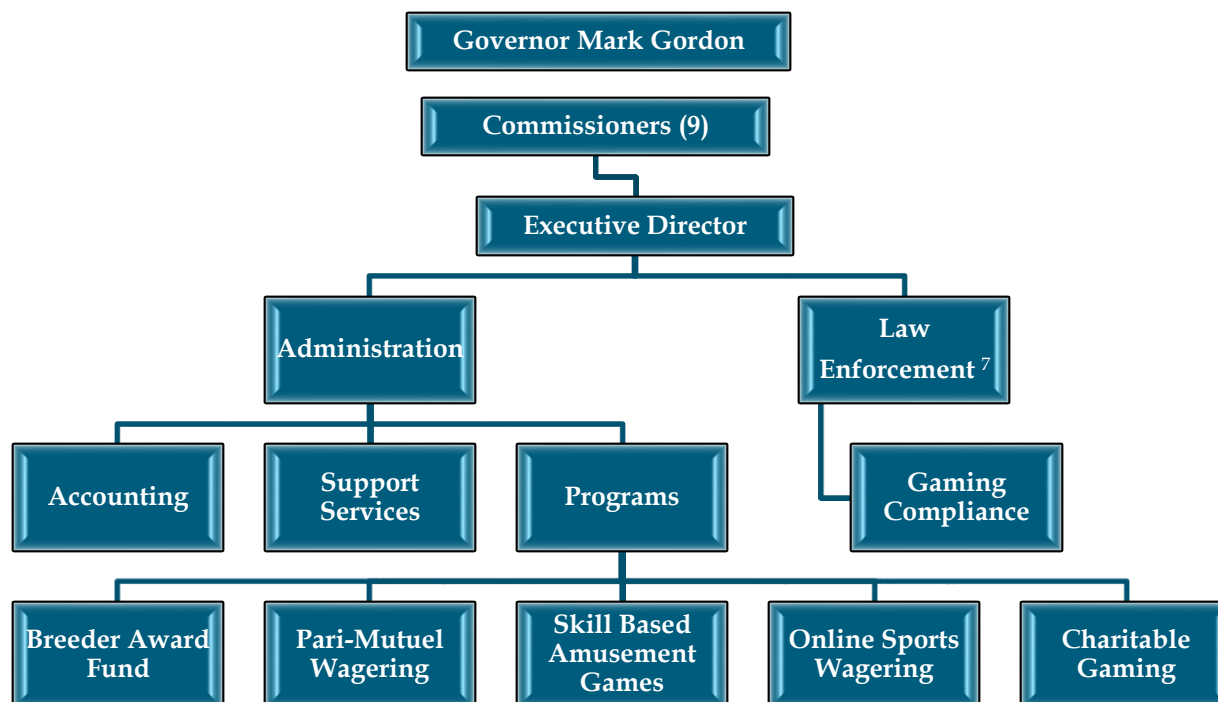

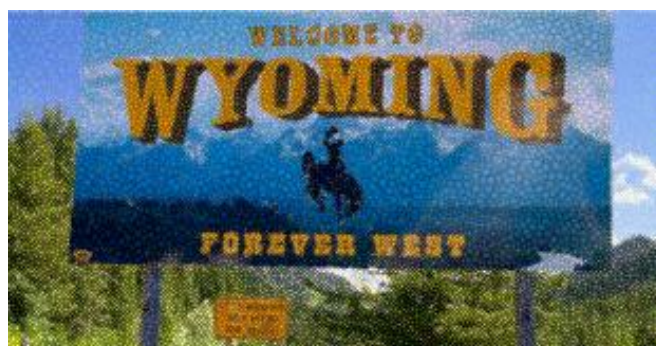
ORGANIZATIONAL CHART



The Wyoming Gaming Commission held its Annual Fall Meeting on November 16, 2022, located at the Thyra Thompson State Office Building, 444 West Collins Drive, Casper, WY. In addition to the annual fall meeting, the Commission held ten (10) special meetings, of which five (5) meetings were held via Zoom, and the other five (5) meetings were held in-person.

Commissioners and staff of the Wyoming Gaming Commission strictly adhere to the Code of Ethics set forth by Governor Geringer on December 3, 1997.

⁷ Pursuant to W.S. § 6-1-104(a)(vi)(R) “peace officer” includes the following officers assigned to duty in the State of Wyoming: Any person qualified pursuant to W.S. 9-1-701 through 9-1-707 and employed by the Wyoming Gaming Commission when engaged in the performance of that person’s duties or when responding to a request to assist other peace officers acting within the scope of their official duties in their own jurisdiction.



AGENCY PROGRAMS

The Wyoming Gaming Commission, originally known as the Wyoming Pari-Mutuel Commission, was first established during the 1967 General Session, House Bill No. 130, authorizing pari-mutuel wagering on live racing. During the 1986 General Session, Senate File No. 45 expanded the commission to seven (7) members and provided for a fund for breeders' awards. In 1991, House Bill No. 305 authorized simulcasting, before providing for out-of-state simulcasting facilities and source market fees in House Bill No. 31, during the 2011 General Session. In 2013, House Bill No. 25 redefined simulcast to include historic pari-mutuel events.

During the 2020 Budget Session, House Bill No. 171 was passed, reconstituting the Wyoming Pari-Mutuel Commission as the Wyoming Gaming Commission, authorizing skill-based amusement games and charitable gaming, which included bingo, pull tabs, and Calcutta Wagering. In 2021, House Bill No. 133 was passed during the General Session, authorizing online sports wagering.



BREEDER AWARD FUND

Pursuant to W.S. §§ 11-25-102(a)(i), 11-25-201(d)(j), and 11-25-201(m)(iii), the Wyoming Gaming Commission is charged with the administration of the Wyoming Breeder Award Fund. The purpose of the Wyoming Breeder Award Fund is to promote the improved breeding and development of the horse industry in the State of Wyoming.

The program offers an exceptional opportunity for owners, breeders, and stallion owners, of accredited Wyoming bred horses to earn significant monetary award incentives, while serving as the backbone to a valuable agricultural industry in the cowboy state.

The Wyoming Gaming Commission is the regulatory agency that serves as the official registrar and administrator of the Wyoming Breeder Award Program. The agency is tasked with ensuring the integrity of program rules and the welfare of the horses and participants.

Wyoming Gaming Commission special agents are tasked with verifying the location and identity of every Wyoming Bred mare and stallion at least once per year.

PARI-MUTUEL WAGERING

Pursuant to W.S. §§ 11-25-201 through 11-25-209, the Wyoming Gaming Commission is charged with the issuance of operator permits and occupational licenses, on-site monitoring, and the enforcement of the Statutes and Rules related to pari-mutuel wagering, including live racing, historic horse racing, simulcasting, and advanced deposit wagering.

The Agency's authority includes:

Licensing and permitting of all entities that are involved with pari-mutuel wagering, including racetrack operators, vendors, service providers, and individuals who participate in live race meets. This includes those directly involved with the race track, off track betting sites, simulcast, and advanced deposit wagering.

Allocation and approval of race dates, supervision of race conduct, the monitoring of the health and safety of the race animals, and ensuring animals are racing without the use of prohibited substances through drug testing of hair, blood, and urine samples.

Oversight of all pari-mutuel wagering activity, approval of simulcast systems, the auditing of tote systems and historic racing terminals, to ensure the proper allocation and distribution of revenue generated by all pari-mutuel wagering.

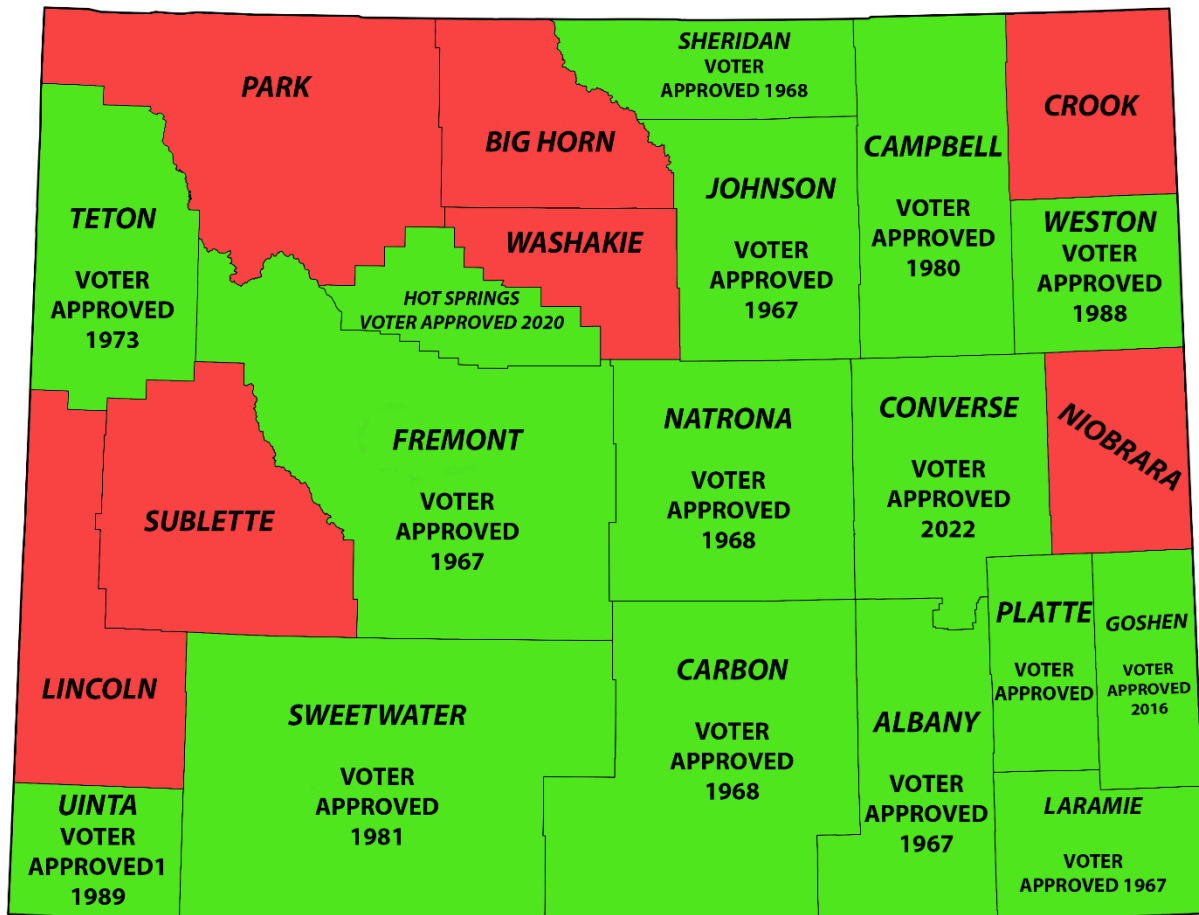

LICENSING & PERMITTING

Each participant of an event, or employee of a licensed establishment, is fingerprinted and verified through a background check. Each licensee is issued a license and an identification badge with their photo and license number displayed. The identification badge shall provide authority to access all areas of the grounds or licensed establishment. Persons holding a license or permit issued by the Wyoming Gaming Commission are required to comply with all rules and regulations of the Wyoming Statutes, as well as all orders and rules issued by the Agency.

License amounts are set by the agency and may be purchased for a one (1) or three (3) years.

CONTRACT PERSONNEL

State Stewards: Pursuant to W.S. § 11-25-104(g), the agency may delegate three (3) Stewards, per race meet, charged with the duty of enforcing Commission Rules of Racing, Pari-Mutuel Events, and State Statutes W.S. §§ 11-25-101 through 11-25-104, & W.S. §§ 11-25-201 through 11-25-209.¹

Safety Officer/Deputy Steward: One (1) Safety Officer/Deputy Steward, per race meet, is charged with monitoring all safety aspects resulting from Live Race Meet operations, both human and equine, to ensure the safety and integrity of racing compliance with horse racing laws and regulations.

Veterinarian and Veterinary Assistant: One (1) Veterinarian or Veterinary Assistant, per live race meet, is responsible for the administration of the Agency's Drug Testing Policy and the general health and safety of the animals involved.¹

DRUG SCREENING & TESTING

At the expense of the Agency, blood, urine, and hair analysis are conducted on horses participating in live racing events. Industrial Laboratories Company, Inc., based in Denver, Colorado, performs the analysis for the detection of illegal and impermissible drugs, as well as abuse of permissible medications.

LICENSING AND FEES

Pursuant to Wyoming Administrative Rules on Pari-Mutuel, Chapter 10, Section 3. Requirements for Simulcast Facilities. Any racing association or corporation authorized to conduct pari-mutuel wagering under this chapter, desiring to display the simulcast of live or historic pari-mutuel events on which pari-mutuel betting shall be permitted in the manner and subject to the conditions provided for under these rules, may apply to the Commission for a license. Applications for permits shall be in such a form as may be prescribed by the Commission and shall contain such information or other material or evidence as the Commission may require. The fee for such permits shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each operator per event day payable by the Permittee to the Commission.

Each of the three (3) operators were permitted to simulcast three-hundred sixty-three (363) days in 2022.

REGULATORY OVERSIGHT

Video surveillance for each Off Track Betting (OTB) facility offering Historic Horse Racing is required by the Agency. Video feed from each establishment is livestreamed and accessible for viewing at the agency's office and the agency's law enforcement personnel have access to all video feeds from mobile devices. Facility inspections are conducted on a regular basis to verify compliance with simulcasting statute, rules and regulations, including terminal stickers, terminal functionality, and software verifications. Additionally, the agency's law enforcement personnel are involved in the verification of all jackpot winnings.

There were one-hundred one (101) inspections completed in 2022.

TESTING AND AUDITS

Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI), is an independent laboratory retained by the agency to serve as an independent consultant on gaming-related matters. Additionally, GLI conducts third-party testing on all historic racing game themes for compliance in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agency's rules and regulations.

GLI also conducts on-site audits concerning historic racing terminal software packages, ensuring all software is up-to-date and in accordance with current rules and regulations.

The Thoroughbred Racing Protective Bureau (TRPB) mandate is to expose and investigate all activity prejudicial to horse racing and to maintain public confidence in the sport of racing. TRPB performs a monthly audit of historic horse racing terminals and on-site terminal verification.

Agency staff execute and review independent daily terminal reporting audits, including but not limited to: county/city allocations, transactions, liabilities, IRS reports, machine sales (handle), and pool summaries.

GLI completed one-thousand eight hundred thirty-two (1,832) tests and audits in 2022.

TRPB completed four (4) onsite inspections and weekly wagering activity audits in 2022.



FINANCIAL REPORT

Pursuant to W.S. § 11-25-201(b), (i)-(iv), (j), the Wyoming Gaming Commission distributes the taxes from Historic Horse Racing as follows:

1% of the total amount wagered is attributable to historic pari-mutuel wagering events. This is shown by the report to the commission, to be transferred by the commission to the county and city or town in which the permittee is located, in equal shares, or to the county alone, if the permittee is not located within the boundaries of a city or town;

One-quarter percent (1/4%) of the total amount wagered attributable to historic pari-mutuel events, shown by the report to the commission, to be credited by the state treasurer to a separate account; and

One-quarter percent (1/4%) of the total amount wagered attributable to historic pari-mutuel events, shown by the report to the commission, to be credited to the legislative stabilization reserve account (LSRA).

ADVANCED DEPOSIT WAGERING (ADW)

Pursuant to W.S. § 11-25-201(m), the Wyoming Gaming Commission may license, regulate and charge a source market fee to persons outside of Wyoming who conduct pari-mutuel wagering on simulcast races and who accept wagers from Wyoming residents at out-of-state simulcast facilities, and shall require out-of-state simulcast facilities licensed under this section to be maintained and operated in accordance with the laws of this state and rules of the commission. Source market fees imposed on persons licensed under this subsection shall not exceed ten percent (10%) of the gross receipts of all pari-mutuel wagering by Wyoming residents conducted by such persons at out-of-state simulcast facilities. Source market fees collected annually under this subsection shall be distributed as follows:

Seventy-Five Percent (75%) to the live flat track permittees in this state on a number of live days basis, to be used to enhance purses at those tracks;

Ten Percent (10%) to in-state Wyoming simulcast permittees, weighted by the annual simulcast handle other than the advanced deposit wagering handle;

Ten Percent (10%) to the breeder award fund created under subsection (j) of this section; and

Five Percent (5%) to the Commission for administrative expenses.

SKILL BASED AMUSEMENT GAMES

Pursuant to W.S. §§ 11-25-301 through 11-25-306, the Wyoming Gaming Commission is charged with the administration, enforcement, and regulation of skill based amusement games (SBAG). Each approved Vendor shall remit an amount equivalent to twenty percent (20%) of the net proceeds earned during the prior week on the Vendor's SBAG terminals.

LICENSING AND FEES

Pursuant to W.S. Statute § 11-25-304(a)(i) an Operator shall pay two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for a permit to have Skill Based Amusement Games operate for play in their establishment. This fee is due annually by July 1st.

Pursuant to W.S. Statute § 11-25-304(a)(ii) a Vendor shall pay two thousand five-hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) to possess and distribute Skill Based Amusement Games. This fee is due annually by July 1st.

REGULATORY OVERSIGHT

Pursuant to W.S. § 11-25-304(b), Skill Based Amusement Games that meet the requirements of this article shall bear a commission issued decal that identifies the vendor of the game. Each decal shall be valid for one (1) year. No skill based amusement game shall be operational unless it bears a current commission issued decal. The commission shall charge the vendor a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for a decal. Each decal shall include the bucking horse and rider emblem.

Agency's law enforcement personnel frequently inspect these terminals on a random basis to verify that these stickers are current and to verify approved software versions remain in operation.

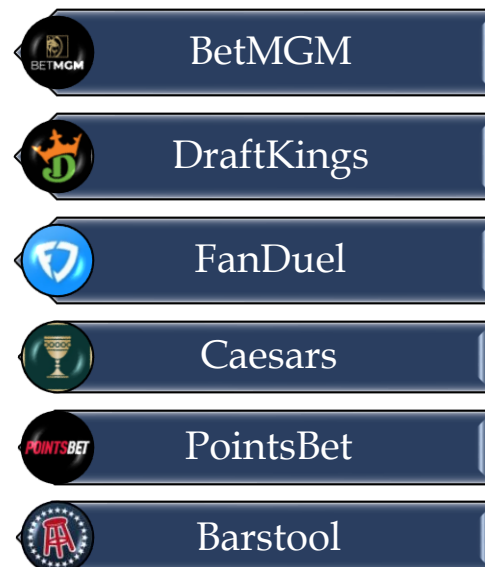
ONLINE SPORTS WAGERING

Pursuant to W.S. §§ 9-24-101 through 9-24-106, the Wyoming Gaming Commission is charged with the administration, enforcement, and regulation of Online Sports Wagering (OSW).

Online Sports Wagering launched in Wyoming in 2021 with three initial operators; BetMGM, DraftKings, and FanDuel. During 2022, the Wyoming Gaming Commission approved three additional operators; Caesars, PointsBet, and Barstool. Currently, only Caesars is operational within the state.

In 2022 the Wyoming Gaming Commission also approved and permitted 11 (eleven) new vendors offering Know Your Customer (KYC), Data Providing, and Payment Processing services to the operators.

The Wyoming Gaming Commission continued to add wagering opportunities to our ever expanding [Online Sports Wagering Catalog](#) in an effort to afford Wyoming patrons a diverse and exciting wagering experience.

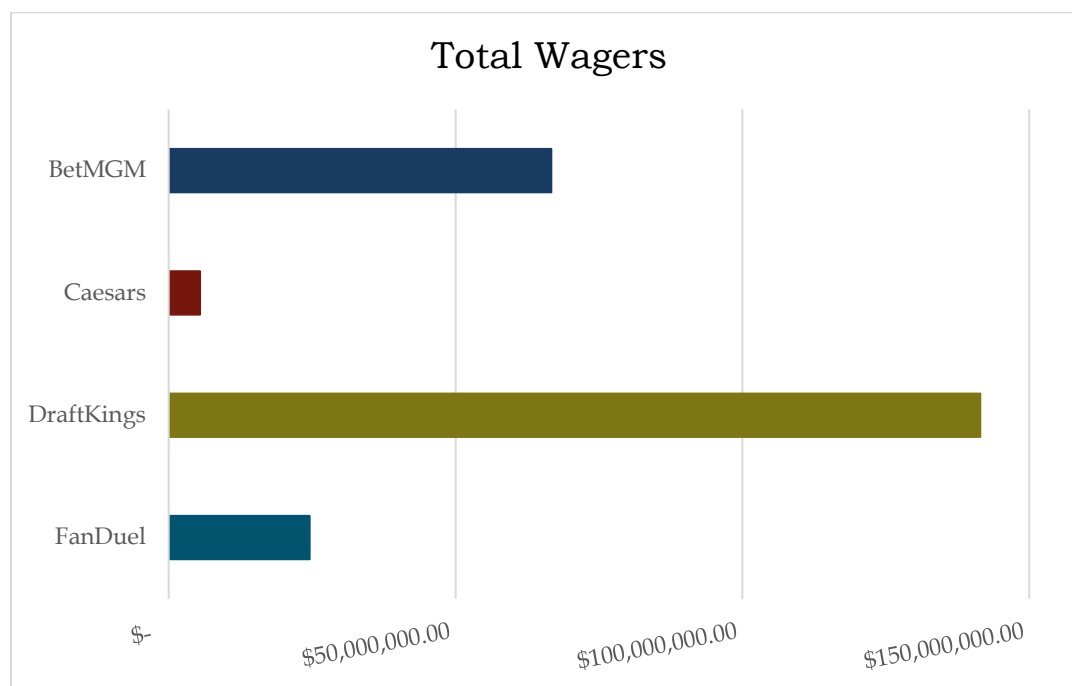

FINANCIAL REPORT

Each Online Sports Wagering Operator shall remit ten percent (10%) of online sports wagering revenue from the prior month to the commission. Each fiscal year, the first three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) of revenue generated shall be continuously appropriated to the Department of Health to be distributed to the counties for the purpose of funding county health programs to prevent and treat problematic gambling behavior. The remainder of monies remitted to the commission shall be deposited by the state treasurer into the general fund.

CHARITABLE GAMING

Pursuant to W.S. §§ 6-7-101 through 6-7-104, the Wyoming Gaming Commission is charged with the administration, enforcement, and regulation of Bingo Games, Pull-Tab Games, and Calcutta Wagering. Bingo Games and Pull-Tab Games must be conducted by a charitable or nonprofit organization which is recognized as such by the State of Wyoming statutes and has a valid 501(c) exemption from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), and has also been in existence in Wyoming for the past three (3) years. Calcutta Wagering must be conducted by a bona fide nationally chartered veterans, religious, charitable, educational or fraternal organization or nonprofit local civic or service club organized or incorporated under the laws of Wyoming.

LICENSING AND FEES

Licensure for Charitable Gaming is required. The Wyoming Gaming Commission does not charge a fee for these licenses, but does require that every entity file an annual report for their establishment.

Calcutta Wagering

- Can only be conducted by bona fide nationally chartered veterans, religious, charitable, educational or fraternal organization or nonprofit local civic or service club organized or incorporated under the laws of Wyoming.
- At least 10% of the gross proceeds are donated within (1) year to a charitable or benevolent purpose.
- Calcutta rules are clearly posted.
- No separate person or professional person is employed to conduct the contest or event.
- The governing body of the town or county of the event receives a (30) day written notice of the time and place of the event and does not pass a resolution objecting.

- The Bingo tickets can only be sold in Wyoming.
- Traditional Bingo and Pull-Tabs games only.
- Pull-Tabs can only be sold on the premises owned/occupied by the charity or nonprofit.



RESPONSIBLE GAMING

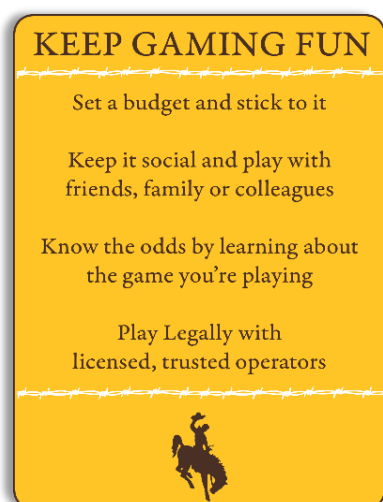
Even though there is little written in statute, the agency is voluntarily involved in the promotion of tools and resources to promote safe and responsible gaming. Our ongoing philosophy is to support responsible gaming. It is our goal to get the word out to our patrons to play, have fun, and know when to walk away.

When HEA50 was enacted for Online Sports Wagering, the first three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) in revenue for the state was dedicated to continuously be appropriated to the Wyoming Department of Health. The funds are distributed to the counties for the purpose of funding county health programs which prevent and treat problematic gambling behavior. The agency became more involved with what is developing in this area of the industry by serving as an active member of the following entities:

- **National Council for Responsible Gambling** – Our Responsible Gaming Liaison receives updates and follows ever changing guidelines of the Council, while also attending zoom meetings for new information delivered by the president of NCRG.
- **Wyoming Responsible Gambling Coalition** – This Coalition meets monthly and is in the process of developing studies focused on the broader scope of gaming as it relates to the people and state of Wyoming.
- **American Gaming Association** – We look for guidance, as well as media tools provided by the AGA to utilize in getting Responsible Gaming messages to our patrons.

In addition, the agency is actively involved in Conscious Gaming round table discussions. Monthly meetings are held in a round table zoom environment giving our liaison the ability to lend information and ideas that will work in Wyoming for self-exclusion and mandatory exclusion information sharing.

We provide Responsible Gaming brochures to each of the operating Off Track Betting locations in Wyoming and have the template for our Responsible Gaming poster on our website. Operators are encouraged to download the poster from the agency's website and post in their respective locations.

What are the symptoms of Problem Gambling?
