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        (c) Within fifteen (15) days after the a conveyance
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    is executed and completed recorded, the county clerk shall
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   report each the conveyance that involves any property
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   located within a critical infrastructure zone or that is
   located not more than five (5) miles from a critical
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   infrastructure zone to the director and to the division of
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   criminal investigation.
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        (d) Upon receiving a report from a county clerk under
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   subsection (c) of this section, the director and the
   division of criminal investigation shall determine whether
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1	a conveyance is within a critical infrastructure zone or
2	located not more than five (5) miles from a critical
3	infrastructure zone and, upon reasonable suspicion,
4	investigate the conveyance to determine if the conveyance
5	involves a designated country or person or if the
6	conveyance poses a threat to national or state security or
7	to critical infrastructure.
