Sec. 3051 et seq., to provide services consistent with the enforcement of the horseracing 14 15 anti-doping and medication control program and the 16 racetrack safety program. Subject to the availability of 17 funds in the pari-mutuel account, there is continuously 18 appropriated to the commission the state's proportionate 19 share for the horseracing anti-doping and medication 20 control program and racetrack safety program calculated 21 under 15 U.S.C. Sec. 3052(f)(1)(C). The commission shall
