- 7 **Section 1**. W.S. 15-1-603(a) is amended to read:
- 9 15-1-603. Regulations; protest makes change
- 10 ineffective; exception; hearing and notice.
- 12 (a) If there is a protest against a change in the 13 regulations, restrictions or district boundaries signed by

1	the owners who can demonstrate a concrete and
2	particularized harm and who own of twenty percent (20%)
3	fifty percent (50%) or more of the area of the lots
4	included in the proposed change, or of those the owners
5	immediately adjacent within a distance of one hundred forty
б	(140) five hundred (500) feet, the change is not effective
7	except upon the affirmative vote of three-fourths (3/4) a
8	majority of all the members of the governing body. In
9	determining the one hundred forty (140) five hundred (500)
10	feet, the width of any intervening street or alley shall
11	not be included.

13	Section 2. This act shall apply to protests filed on
14	and after July 1, 2025.
