AN ACT relating to school finance; authorizing school 1 2 districts to submit billing for child health insurance program eligible special education services as specified; 3 requiring school districts to submit billing for Medicaid 4 5 and child health insurance program eligible special 6 education services specified; as making conforming 7 amendments; deleting an obsolete provision; providing an appropriation; authorizing a full-time position; 8 and 9 providing for an effective date.

11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

1 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-13-321(h) and (j) is amended to 2 read: 3 21-13-321. Special education; amount provided for 4 5 special education programs and services; district reporting 6 requirements; billing for Medicaid and child health insurance program authorized school based services. 7 8 9 (h) Beginning July 1, 2022 July 1, 2026, each school 10 district with less than two thousand five hundred (2,500) 11 students and with Medicaid or child health insurance 12 program eligible students receiving special 13 programs and services, as calculated by the department of 14 education pursuant to subsection (j) of this section, may bill the department of health for the costs of any special 15 education program and service provided to the district's 16 students covered by the child health insurance program or 17 18 Medicaid under W.S. 42-4-103(a)(xxxiv) through (xxxvi) provided to the district's students. Beginning July 1, 19 20 2026, each school district with two thousand five hundred (2,500) students or more and with Medicaid or child health 21

insurance program eligible students receiving special

Τ	education programs and services, as calculated by the
2	department of education pursuant to subsection (j) of this
3	section, shall bill the department of health for the costs
4	of any special education program and service provided to
5	the district's students covered by the child health
6	insurance program or Medicaid under W.S. 42-4-103(a)(xxxiv)
7	through (xxxvi). The department of health shall provide
8	payment to each eligible school district that has billed
9	the department of health as soon as reasonably practical
10	for the costs of approved services. By September 1 of each
11	school year, each school district shall remit to the
12	department of education all funds received during the prior
13	school year from the department of health for billed
14	services. The department of education shall remit all funds
15	received under this subsection to the state treasurer for
16	deposit in the <pre>public</pre> school foundation program account.

(j) A school district may report the number of Medicaid eligible students receiving special education programs and services enrolled within the school district on forms and in such manner required by the department for the 2021-2022 school year. Beginning with the 2022-2023

1 2026-2027 school year and each school year thereafter, a 2 school district shall report the number of Medicaid and 3 child health insurance program eligible students receiving 4 special education programs and services enrolled within the 5 school district on forms and in the manner required by the 6 department. The total number of students in each school 7 district and the number of Medicaid or child health insurance program eligible students 8 receiving special 9 education programs and services for a school year shall be 10 determined by the department of education using data from 11 October 1 of the immediately preceding school year.

13 Section 2. The department of education is 14 authorized one (1) full-time employee to assist school districts in submission of required information to obtain 15 reimbursement for Medicaid and child health insurance 16 program eligible special education program and services 17 18 pursuant to this act. There is appropriated to the 19 department of education two hundred fifty-five thousand two 20 hundred fifty dollars (\$255,250.00) from the general fund 21 for the salary and benefits of the position created by this 22 section for the period beginning July 1, 2026 and ending

1 June 30, 2028. These funds shall not b	e transferred o

- 2 expended for any other purpose and any unexpended,
- 3 unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall
- 4 revert as provided by law. It is the intent of the
- 5 legislature that two hundred fifty-five thousand two
- 6 hundred fifty dollars (\$255,250.00) and this position be
- 7 included in the department of education's standard budget
- 8 for the immediately succeeding fiscal biennium.

10 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2026.
