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2 (b) A grant awarded under this section shall be for a 3 period of two (2) years and shall not exceed fifty thousand 4 dollars (\$50,000.00) seventy-five thousand dollars 5 (\$75,000.00) per year. Applications for a grant under this section shall be submitted on a form and in a manner 6 specified by rule of the department, shall be filed with 7 8 the department on or before June 30 to secure a grant 9 during the immediately succeeding school year and shall at a minimum include: 10

(c) Not later than August 15 of the applicable school

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year and following review of applications submitted under 13 section, the department shall notify applicant 14 15 districts of its grant awards and shall provide each 16 applicant district a written statement of the reasons for 17 approving or denying the application. No award shall be given to a district unless it has expended, or will expend 18 19 with the award of the grant requested under this section, 20 the entire amount generated under W.S. 21-13-309(m)(v)(D)21 for supplies, materials and equipment for career and technical education programs utilizing expenditure data 22 23 from the immediately preceding five (5) two (2) school

1	years from the date of application and amounts from the
2	special reserve fund created under W.S. 21-13-504 for
3	supplies, materials and equipment for career and technical
4	education programs. Further, Preference shall be given to
5	districts that have not received a grant under this section
6	in the immediately preceding five (5) school years from the
7	date of application. If an application is approved, the
8	department shall award the grant from amounts made
9	available by legislative appropriation from the public
10	school foundation program account for purposes of this
11	section.
