- If livestock from privately owned adjoining lands stray 12 onto state lands, the office of state lands and investments 13

- 1 or the lessee shall be responsible to fence the affected
- 2 state lands rather than the adjoining private landowner.
- 3 The office of state lands and investments shall not seek a
- 4 trespass action against the livestock owner if the only
- 5 grounds for the action are livestock straying onto unfenced
- 6 state lands that do not comply with W.S. 11-28-102. Nothing
- 7 in this section shall be deemed to limit any liability
- 8 under W.S. 11-28-108 for state lands enclosed by lawful
- 9 fence as provided in W.S. 11-28-102.

- 12 shall promulgate all rules necessary to implement this act.
