9	Section 1. W.S. 17-33-101 is created to read:

12	NATURAL ASSET COMPANIES

1	17-33-101. Natural asset companies; definition;
2	prohibition.
3	
4	(a) As used in this section, "natural asset company"
5	means a company:
6	
7	(i) That holds a conservation easement in
8	Wyoming or has the rights to the ecological performance,
9	including value from natural assets and the production of
L 0	ecosystem services, of a defined land area in Wyoming and
L1	has the authority to manage such area for conservation,
L2	restoration or sustainable management; and

L 4	(ii) The primary purpose, with respect to such
L 5	defined land area in Wyoming, is to:
L 6	
L7	(A) Manage, maintain, restore and grow the
L 8	value of natural assets and the production of ecosystem
L 9	services in the area; or

21	(B) Carry out activities that do not cause
22	any material adverse impact on the condition of the natural

1	assets in the area and replenish the natural resources used
2	in the area.
3	
4	(b) It shall be unlawful for a natural asset company
5	having a conservation easement or defined land area
6	entirely within Wyoming to sell its credits through a
7	national securities exchange registered under 15 U.S.C.
8	78f. This subsection shall not prohibit a natural asset
9	company from selling its credits if it has holdings outside
10	the state of Wyoming.
11	
12	Section 2. This act shall apply to natural asset
13	companies with conservation easements or defined land areas
14	entirely within Wyoming on or after the effective date of
15	this act.
16	
17	Section 3. This bill is effective immediately upon
18	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
19	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
20	Constitution.
