3 licenses as specified; removing minimum contribution
4 requirements to property damage compensation fund;
5 requiring rulemaking; and providing for effective dates.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-2-101(e) is amended to read:

1 23-2-101. Fees; restrictions; nonresident application fee;
2 nonresident licenses; verification of residency required;
3 donation of refunded application fees.

5 (e) Resident and nonresident license applicants shall
6 pay an application fee in an amount specified by this
7 subsection upon submission of an application for purchase
8 of any limited quota drawing for big or trophy game license
9 or wild bison license. ~~The resident application fee~~
10 Application fees shall be ~~five dollars (\$5.00)~~ established
11 by rule and shall not exceed twenty dollars (\$20.00) for
12 resident applications and ~~the seventy-five dollars (\$75.00)~~
13 for nonresident ~~application fee shall be fifteen dollars~~
14 ~~(\$15.00)~~ applications for all personal applications made at
15 the same time. The application fee is in addition to the
16 fees prescribed by subsections (f) and (j) of this section
17 and by W.S. 23-2-107 and shall be payable to the department
18 either directly or through an authorized selling agent of
19 the department. ~~At the beginning of each month, the~~
