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9-1-302. Powers and duties; custodian of public records; preservation of executive orders and proclamations of governor; removal of public documents prohibited;

4 exceptions.

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6 (a) The secretary of state is the custodian of, and 7 shall preserve:

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9 (ii) All executive orders issued by a governor, 10 proclamations of the governor proclaiming the effectiveness 11 of constitutional amendments, corporate revocations and any 12 other proclamation designated as a permanent record by the governor. The secretary of state shall preserve all other 13 proclamations of the governor for one (1) year and then 14 15 deliver them to the department of state parks and cultural 16 resources for destruction or preservation as it deems desirable +. As used in this paragraph, "executive order" 17 18 means a proclamation or order executed by the governor pursuant to constitutional or statutory authority to 19 20 implement any provision of law; provided "executive order" 21 does not include:

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1	(A) A proclamation issued by the governor
