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7	Section 1. W.S. 31-5-1105 and 31-5-1106(c) are

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10	31-5-1105. Notice required of driver.
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1 The driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting 2 in injury to or death of any person, in property damage to 3 another or others to an apparent the extent of at least one 4 thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or in any the vehicle, excluding bicycles or any other vehicle moved solely by 5 human power, becoming is so disabled as to prevent its 6 normal and safe operation, shall immediately by the 7 8 quickest means of communication give notice of the accident 9 to the local police department if the accident occurs 10 within a municipality, otherwise to the nearest office of 11 the state highway patrol or to the office of the county 12 sheriff.

(c) Every police officer who investigates a motor vehicle accident resulting in bodily injury to or death of any person or total property damage to <u>an apparent the</u> extent of <u>one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00)</u> or <u>more the</u> <u>vehicle is so disabled as to prevent its normal and safe</u> <u>operation</u>, either at the time of and at the scene of the accident or thereafter by interviewing the participants or

2	the highway department within ten (10) days after his
