## A BILL

## for

1 AN ACT relating to defense forces and affairs; expanding eligibility for the Wyoming national guard member referral 2 incentive program; providing a definition; and providing 3 4 for an effective date. 5 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 Section 1. W.S. 19-9-403(e)(intro), (i), (ii), and 8 9 (iv) by creating a new subparagraph (C), and by renumbering 10 subparagraph (C) as (D) is amended to read:

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19-9-403. Pay and allowances of officers and enlisted
persons in active state service and state active duty;
worker's compensation coverage for national guard members;
no pension denied by reason of service.

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There is created the Wyoming national guard 6 (e) 7 member referral incentive program. The purpose of the 8 program shall be to incentivize and maximize peer-to-peer recruiting that results in a completed accession to the 9 Wyoming national guard by providing a referral bonus to 10 11 Wyoming national guard members, retired military service 12 members, current employees of the military department or recruits beginning the enlistment process with the Wyoming 13 14 national guard who make a successful referral. 15 Administration of this program shall require that:

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(i) A Wyoming national guard member, retired military service member, current employees of the military department or recruit beginning the enlistment process with the Wyoming national guard may provide the identity and contact information of a person who the member believes would be an appropriate recruitment prospect using a form provided by the Wyoming national guard, which includes the

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1 person's name, contact information and any other 2 information required by the military department; 3 4 (ii) The military department shall keep a record of all forms submitted under paragraph (i) of this subsection. 5 Upon the completed accession of a referred person and to 6 the extent sufficient funds are available, the military 7 8 department shall distribute a referral bonus to the member, retired service member or employee who provided the 9 10 successful referral. The military department shall not distribute a referral bonus to a referring recruit until 11 12 the referring recruit has membership in the Wyoming 13 national guard; 14 (iv) As used in this subsection: 15 16 17 (C) "Retired military service member" means a person who has retired from the armed forces as defined 18 by W.S. 8-1-102(a)(xxi), the army national guard or air 19 20 national guard. 21 22 (C) (D) "Successful referral" means 23 providing the identity and contact information pursuant to

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1	paragraph (e)(i) of this subsection of any person not
2	already a member of the Wyoming national guard that results
3	in a completed accession to the Wyoming national guard.

5	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2025.
