6 (a) The Wyoming community college commission is
7 authorized one (1) full-time position for the purpose of
8 coordinating and assisting in the provision of and
9 fundraising for veteran services at Wyoming community
10 colleges and the University of Wyoming for students
11 attending Wyoming community colleges, the University of
12 Wyoming Casper and the University of Wyoming online.

24 (b) There is appropriated one hundred thousand five
25 hundred twelve dollars (\$106,512.00) from the general fund
26 to the Wyoming community college commission for purposes of
27 funding the position created by subsection (a) of this
28 section for the period beginning July 1, 2025, and ending

1 June 30, 2026. This appropriation shall not be transferred
2 or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended,
3 unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation on June
4 30, 2026 shall revert as provided by law. It is the intent
5 of the legislature that this appropriation and the position
6 authorized in subsection (a) of this section be included in
7 the standard budget for the Wyoming community college
8 commission for the immediately succeeding fiscal biennium.

10 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2025.
