(k) Each facility required to file a tier II report to the commission under 42 U.S.C. § 11022 shall pay a fee to the commission of X dollars (\$X.00) per filing, except that each facility shall not be required to pay more than Y dollars (\$Y.00) in fees under this subsection per year.
