6 commission; and providing for an effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-14-107(c) by creating a new
11 paragraph (xiii), 21-17-207 and 21-18-201(c) are amended to
12 read:

3 **composition; terms.**

7 (xiii) Recommend members of the public
8 representing veterans and veteran services to be appointed
9 by the governor to the university board of trustees and the
10 Wyoming community college commission to serve as ex officio
11 nonvoting members.
