- AN ACT relating to boards and commissions; adding ex officio nonvoting members who represent veterans and veteran services to the University of Wyoming board of trustees and the Wyoming community college commission as specified; amending the duties of the Wyoming veterans' commission; and providing for an effective date.

- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-14-107(c) by creating a new 11 paragraph (xiii), 21-17-207 and 21-18-201(c) are amended to 12 read:

16	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
17	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
18	Constitution.
