A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of government; requiring  
2 an efficiency study by an independent third party to  
3 evaluate the department of transportation; requiring  
4 reporting and recommendations; providing an appropriation;  
5 and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.**

11 (a) There is appropriated two hundred fifty thousand  
12 dollars (\$250,000.00) from the general fund to the

1 governor's office for purposes of conducting an efficiency  
2 study of the department of transportation in accordance  
3 with this section. The study funded by this appropriation  
4 shall:

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6 (i) Be conducted by an independent third party;

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8 (ii) Be conducted in consultation with the joint  
9 transportation, highways and military affairs interim  
10 committee;

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12 (iii) Evaluate the department of transportation's  
13 rules, policies and procedures;

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15 (iv) Review the department of transportation's  
16 staffing and resources and the distribution and number of  
17 staff and resources around the state of Wyoming;

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19 (v) Determine whether efficiencies or costs  
20 savings can be gained;

11 (vi) Provide recommendations for the department  
 12 of transportation to achieve the efficiencies identified in  
 13 paragraph (v) of this subsection;

15 (vii) Include a preliminary report and update to  
 16 the governor, the department of transportation and the  
 17 joint transportation, highways and military affairs interim  
 18 committee not later than October 1, 2025;

20 (viii) Include a final report, containing the  
 21 potential efficiencies identified, recommendations to  
 22 achieve those efficiencies and any recommendations for  
 23 changes to statute, rule, policy or procedure to the  
 24 governor, the department of transportation and the joint  
 25 transportation, highways and military affairs interim  
 26 committee not later than December 1, 2025.

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1           (b) The appropriation in subsection (a) of this  
2 section shall be for the period beginning with the  
3 effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2026. The  
4 appropriation in subsection (a) of this section shall not  
5 be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any  
6 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this  
7 appropriation on June 30, 2026 shall revert as provided by  
8 law.

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10           **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
11 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
12 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
13 Constitution.
