Duties of boards of trustees.
- 12 (a) The board of trustees in each school district
  13 shall:

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2	(x) Subject to review by the school facilities
3	commission under W.S. 21-15-117 for any project involving
4	state capital construction assistance, fix the site of each
5	school building and facility considering the needs of the
6	people of each portion of the district. If the district
7	enters into an agreement to lease buildings and facilities
8	owned by the district and the buildings and facilities are
9	included within the statewide database maintained by the
10	state construction department under W.S. 21-15-123(f)(iv),
11	the district shall, except as provided under W.S.
12	21-15-109(c)(i)(A)(II) and (III) and (B), ensure the lease
13	agreement requires sufficient payment from the lessee to
14	cover expenses necessary to adequately maintain the
15	facility or building in accordance with statewide adequacy
16	standards prescribed by the commission. If the district or
17	a charter school operating within the boundaries of the
18	district enters into an agreement to lease buildings and
19	facilities under which the district or the charter school
20	is the lessee and the building is to be used for the
21	provision of the required educational program within the
22	district, the lease agreement shall require the lessor to

1	adequately maintain the buildings and facilities in
2	accordance with standards prescribed by the commission. The
3	lease agreement shall separately identify the amount to be
4	expended on the major maintenance of the building or
5	facility during the term of the lease. The amount of the
6	total lease agreement to be expended on the major
7	maintenance shall be accounted for and reported separately
8	and shall not be transferred or expended for any purpose
9	other than major maintenance of the leased building or
10	facility. No expenditure shall be made from the funds
11	dedicated for major maintenance of a leased facility
12	without the approval of the district or the charter school.
13	A district or charter school may request review of the
14	amount to be expended on major maintenance for a lease by
15	the school facilities division of the state construction
16	department to determine the reasonableness of the major
17	maintenance expense. The district shall be reimbursed for
18	the lease payment of the district or the charter school if
19	the square footage of the leased facility is not included
20	within the district's total square footage for purposes of
21	major maintenance computations under W.S. 21-15-109,
22	subject to the following:

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2 (B) Any payment made by the department pursuant to this paragraph for a leased building or 3 facility shall not exceed be equal to the lesser of the 4 5 amount of the total lease agreement or the average cost per 6 square foot to lease buildings or facilities comparable to those appropriate for public K-12 education multiplied by 7 the total allowable square feet leased by the district or 8 9 school necessary to deliver the charter required 10 educational program. The average cost per square foot for 11 comparable buildings or facilities shall:
