10 (b) A vacancy in the office of justice of the supreme court or judge of any district court or of such other courts 11 12 that may be made subject to this provision by law, shall be 13 filled by a qualified person appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees that shall be submitted by the 14 judicial nominating commission. The commission shall submit 15 16 such a list not later than 60 days after the death, retirement, tender of resignation, removal, failure of an 17 incumbent to file a declaration of candidacy or certification 18 19 of a negative majority vote on the question of retention in 20 office under section [subsection] (g) hereof. If the governor 21 shall fail to make any such appointment within 30 days from the day the list is submitted to him, such appointment shall 22 23 be made by the chief justice from the list within 15 days. 20	Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse
21 22	the following statement on the proposed amendment:
23	The Wyoming Constitution provides a process by which Wyoming
24	Supreme Court justices are selected through the Judicial
25	Nominating Commission, which forwards three (3) nominees for
26	the Governor to choose from. This amendment would require
27	that, once one (1) of the three (3) nominees is selected by
28	the governor, that person would be required to be confirmed
29	by the Wyoming Senate before assuming office.
