A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the duties of the state superintendent
2 of public instruction; requiring the state superintendent
3 to develop model policies and procedures governing student
4 discipline; specifying a date for development of model
5 policies and procedures; and providing for an effective
6 date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-2-202(a) by creating a new
11 paragraph (xli) is amended to read:

12

13 **21-2-202. Duties of the state superintendent.**

2 (a) In addition to any other duties assigned by law,
3 the state superintendent shall:

4

5 (xli) Establish model policies and procedures to
6 assist local school districts in adoption of policies and
7 procedures to govern student discipline under W.S. 21-4-305
8 through 21-4-308. No district shall be required to adopt
9 any part of the model policies and procedures.

10

11 **Section 2.** Not later than July 1, 2026, the state
12 superintendent shall establish the model policies and
13 procedures required by W.S. 21-2-202(a)(xli) as created by
14 section 1 of this act.

15

16 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
18 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
19 Constitution.
