6	(xiii) "Governmental entity" means the state of
7	Wyoming, an agency, political subdivision or state
8	institution of Wyoming or a local government association;

10	(xv) "Local government association" means any
11	association, the membership of which is composed
12	exclusively of political subdivisions, including boards,
13	commissions, agencies or authorities of a subdivision, or
14	any combination of any of these entities.

20	(d) The custodian shall deny the right of inspection

called by proper authority of the agency for the expressed
