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  7 Section 1. W.S. 22-6-130 by creating a new subsection
- 10 **22-6-130.** Post-election ballot audit.

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1	(c) In addition to the audit under subsections (a)
2	and (b) of this section, following each primary and general
3	election, each county clerk shall conduct an audit of the
4	ballots in one (1) precinct as provided in this subsection.
5	The secretary of state shall randomly select one (1)
6	precinct in each county to be audited as provided in this
7	subsection. The county clerk shall conduct a hand count
8	audit of all ballots cast in the precinct selected by the
9	secretary of state and shall compare the hand count result
10	to the result tabulated by the electronic voting system.
11	The audit under this subsection shall be completed not
12	later than one (1) week after the date of the election. The
13	results of the audit and the comparison shall immediately
14	be reported to the secretary of state. The secretary of
15	state shall adopt rules necessary to implement this
16	subsection, including rules establishing the scope of the
17	audit and the procedures for conducting the audit under
18	this subsection.

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20 **Section 2.** The secretary of state shall adopt rules

21 regarding the hand count audit required under W.S.

22 22-6-130(c), as created by section 1 of this act, not later

than September 1, 2026.

Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
