2 (a) No cause of action shall arise against a person

3 for returning a firearm to a firearm owner at the

4 termination of a firearm hold agreement.

6 (b) The immunity provided in subsection (a) of this

7 section shall not apply to an action arising against a

8 person for returning a firearm to a firearm owner at the

9 termination of a firearm hold agreement if the action was

10 the result of a breach of contract or otherwise unlawful

11 conduct on the part of the person holding a firearm for

12 another person.

14 (c) As used in this section, "firearm hold agreement"

15 means a written or oral agreement between a firearm owner

16 and another person in which the other person takes physical

17 possession of the firearm owner's lawfully possessed

18 firearm at the owner's request, holds the firearm for an

19 agreed period of time and returns the firearm to the owner

20 according to the terms of the agreement.

22 (d) This section shall not apply to items under the

23 National Firearms Act, 26 U.S.C. § 5801 et. seq. including

weapon as defined by 26 U.S.C. § 5845. 2

4 Section 2. This act shall apply to all firearm hold

1 firearms, machine guns, rifles, shotguns and any other

agreements entered into on or after July 1, 2026. 5
