## A BILL

for

- AN ACT relating to medical assistance and services;

  providing for increased reimbursement for emergency medical

  services under the Wyoming medical assistance and services

  act as specified; making appropriations; specifying

  applicability; requiring reports; and providing for an

  effective date.
- 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
- Section 1. For the period beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2028, services authorized under the Wyoming medical assistance and services act involving emergency

- 1 medical services provided by ground ambulance service
- 2 providers shall be reimbursed at one hundred percent (100%)
- 3 of the current Medicare rate, not to exceed one hundred
- 4 percent (100%) of the provider's or department's usual and
- 5 customary billed charges. This reimbursement rate shall
- 6 apply if the services were rendered during the period
- 7 beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2028.

- 9 Section 2. The department of health shall report to
- 10 the joint appropriations committee and the joint labor,
- 11 health and social services interim committee on or before
- 12 October 31, 2027 regarding the additional costs incurred by
- 13 the increased reimbursement rate required by this act. The
- 14 report required by this section shall include any
- 15 recommendations for modifications to the reimbursement rate
- 16 for emergency medical services provided by ground ambulance
- 17 providers under the medical assistance and services act.

- 19 **Section 3.** There is appropriated one million three
- 20 hundred thousand dollars (\$1,300,000.00) from the general
- 21 fund and one million three hundred thousand dollars
- 22 (\$1,300,000.00) from federal funds to the department of
- 23 health for purposes of increasing the reimbursement rate

1	for services as provided by this act. This appropriation
2	shall be for the period beginning July 1, 2026 and ending
3	June 30, 2028. This appropriation shall not be transferred
4	or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended,
5	unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall
6	revert as provided by law on June 30, 2028. It is the
7	intent of the legislature that this appropriation be
8	included in the standard budget for the department of
9	health for the immediately succeeding fiscal biennium.
