(b) Before any vote by the trustees to file bankruptcy or plan to dissolve and terminate a county 11 memorial hospital is effective, the plan the bankruptcy 12 petition and initial plan for the adjustment of debts or the dissolution and termination plan shall be approved by the board of county commissioners. 14

(c) If the board of county commissioners approves the bankruptcy petition and initial plan for adjustment of debts or the dissolution and termination plan, the board of take all action necessary to obtain trustees may confirmation of the plan of adjustment and closure of the case under chapter 9 of the United States bankruptcy code or take all action necessary to effectuate the plan and dissolve and terminate the county memorial hospital.
