Appointments, 12 vacancies and expiration of terms shall be in accordance with W.S. 28-12-101 through 28-12-103. A member shall not 13 hold any state office or serve as an officer or on a 14 15 committee of any political organization during the term of 16 membership. No more than seventy-five percent (75%) of the 17 members shall be of the same political party.

- 8 dollars (\$18,000.00) from the general fund to the Wyoming
